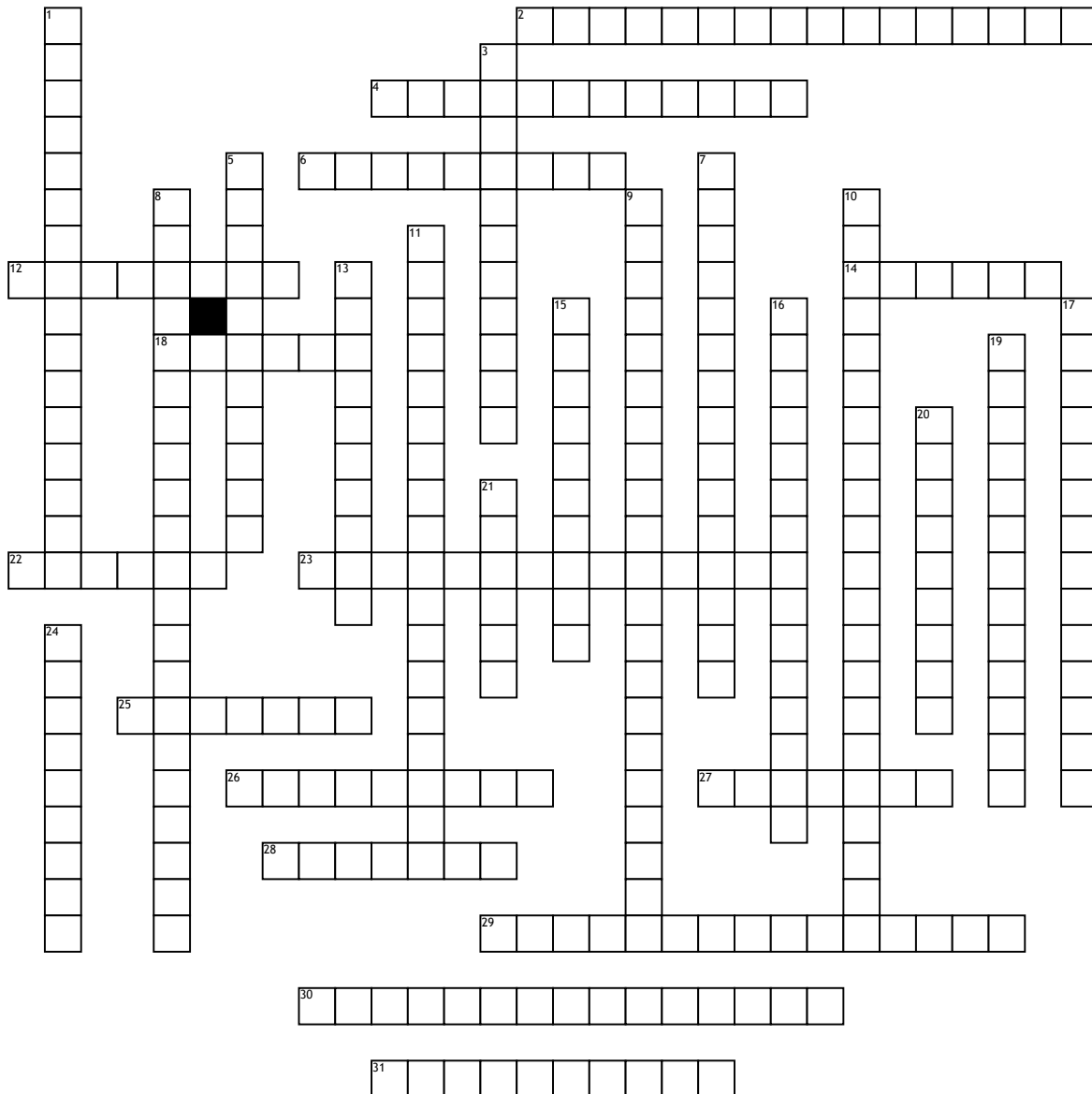

- 2. Rupture of vv linking bv's On cortex surface & Dural sinuses
- 4. General infection of brain and/or Spinal Cord
- 6. Intense, typically intermittent pain along the course of a nerve
- 12. Inflammation of a nerve
- 14. Physical injury or wound caused by external force or violence
- 18. Traumatic or pathological loss of tissue continuity, whether structural or functional
- 22. Damage to a part of the body
- 23. Acceleration-deceleration injury
- 25. Reduction in O2 supply

- 26. Bruising of brain tissue
- 27. Median Nerve Deformity
- 28. Partial/incomplete paralysis; muscle weakness
- 29. Displacement of brain tissue
- 30. Loss of oxygen due to reduced blood flow
- 31. C5-C6 n root injury, "waiter's tip"

- 1. Impaired sympathetic Innervation for vasomotor tone
- 3. Unilateral facial paralysis
- 5. Inflammation of periosteum
- 7. Internal area of an IVD
- 8. Demyelination in PNS

- 9. Disintegration of Axon & its myelin sheath distal to site of injury
- 10. Bleeding in brain tissue
- 11. C8-T1 n root injury "Claw hand"
- 13. Momentary interruption in brain function with or without LOC
- 15. Inflammation of meninges
- 16. External area of an IVD
- 17. Loss of oxygen despite adequate blood supply
- 19. Acute, systemic disorder causing inflammation of SC
- 20. Radial Nerve Deformity
- 21. Lack of O2 supply
- 24. severe burning pain in a limb caused by injury to a peripheral nerve
