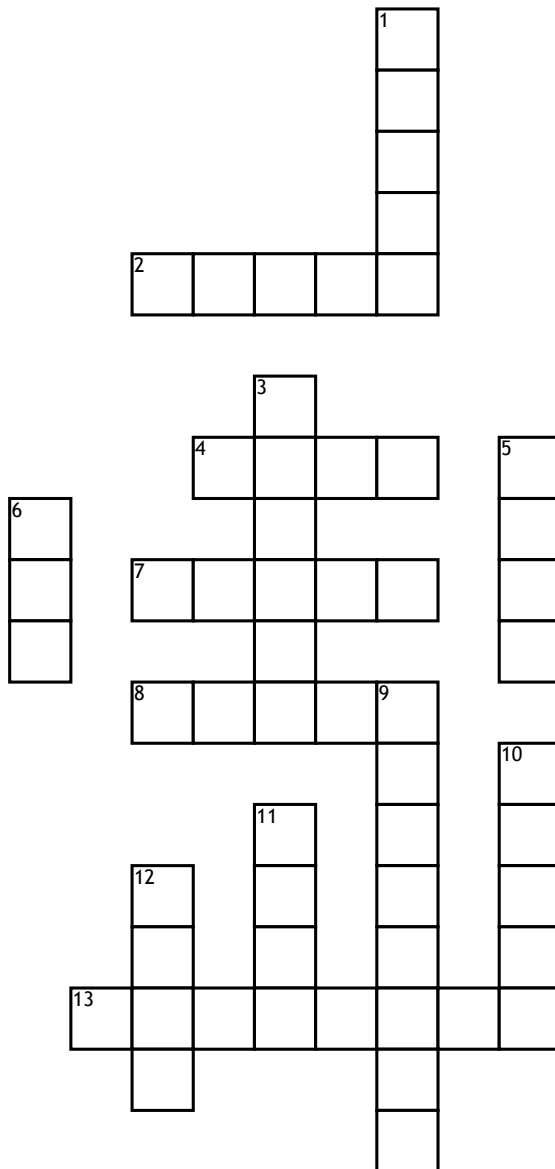


New Jersey Tide Crossword Puzzle
