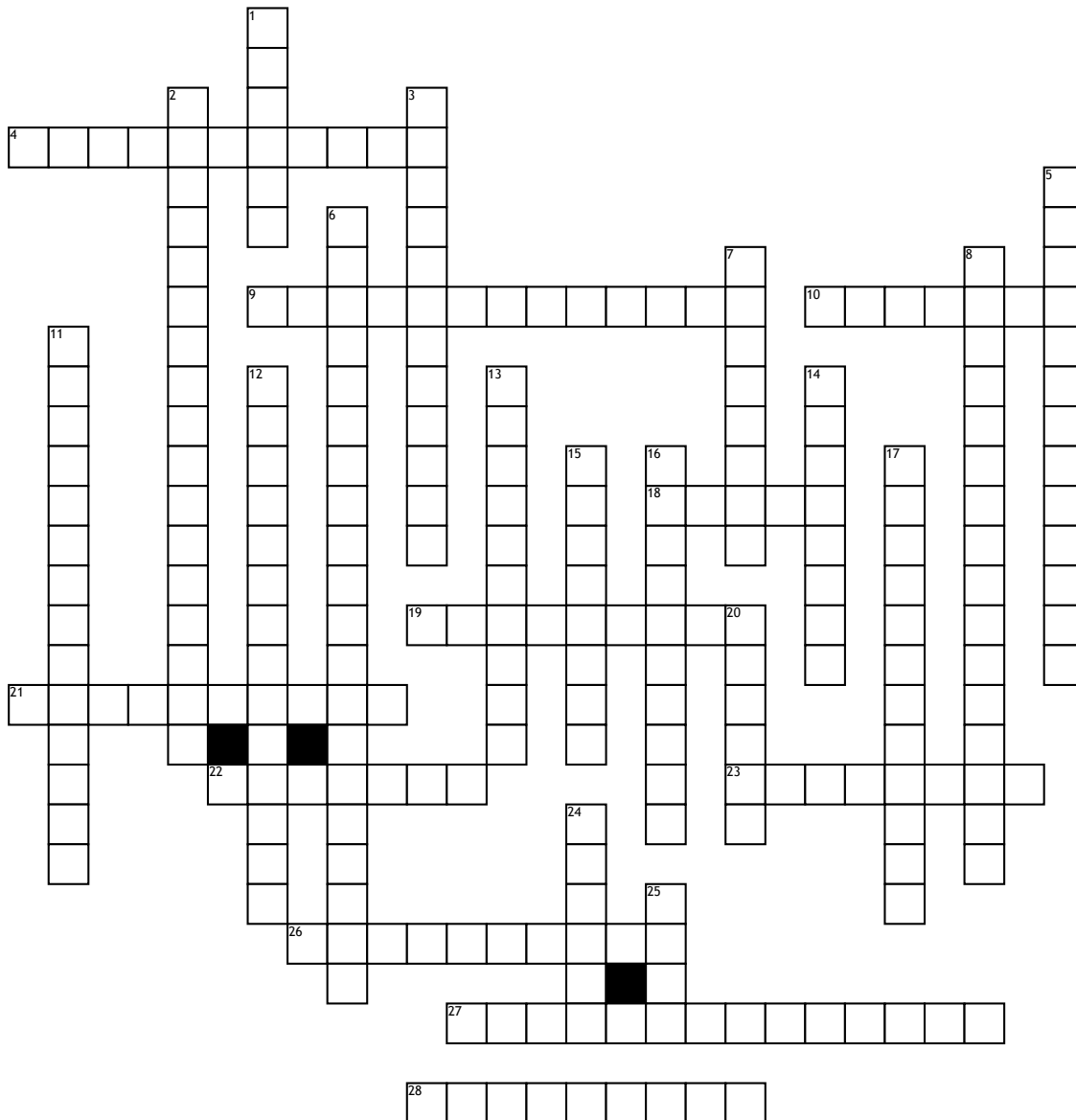


New Republic Vocabulary Crossword Activity
