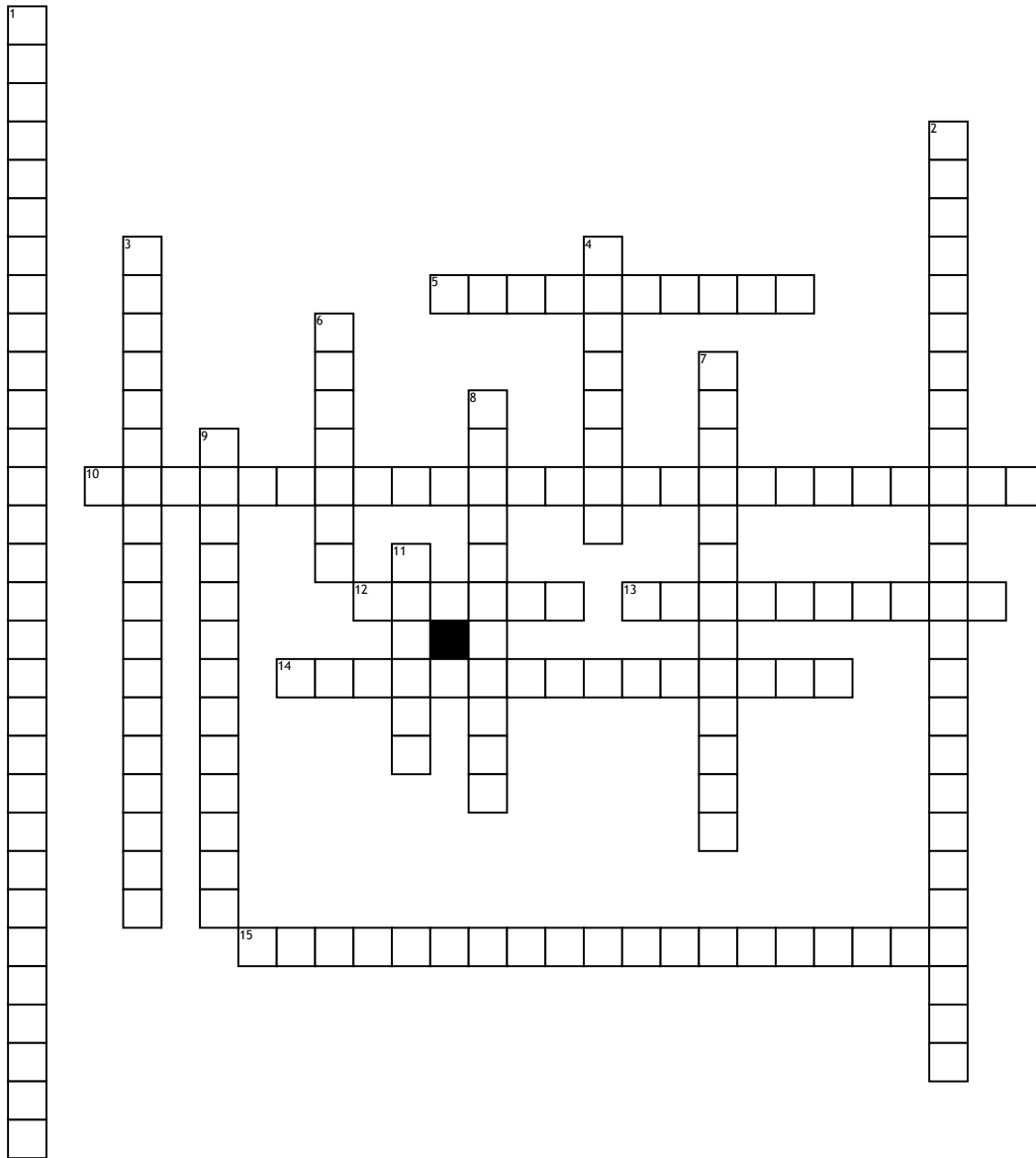

- 5. legislative program focusing on reform begun by FDR in 1935 when the first attempt to end the Depression failed
- 10. Jobs for men aged between 18 and 25 who were Hobos or living in Hoovervilles. Planted trees, stocked rivers and earned a dollar a day. By 1941, more than 2 million men had been employed.
- 12. aim to prevent a similar disastrous depression in the future
- 13. A series of reforms enacted by the Franklin Roosevelt administration between 1933 and 1942 with the goal of ending the Great Depression.
