10. The title of an article printed in boldface

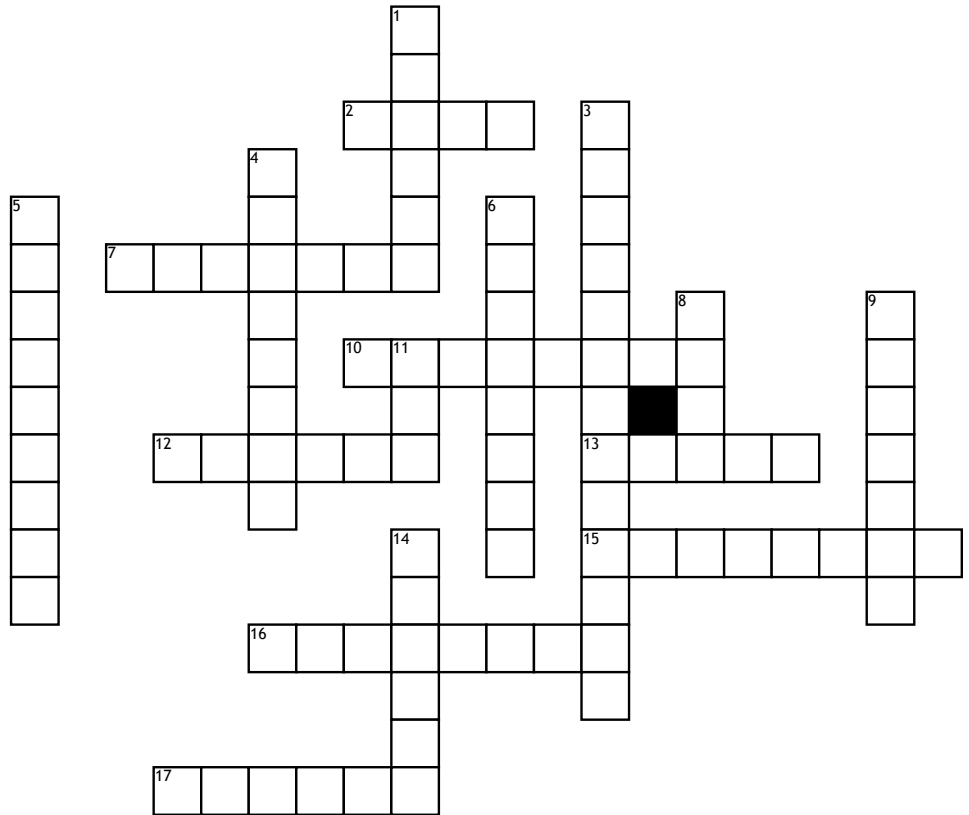
12. A headline that runs across the whole page
