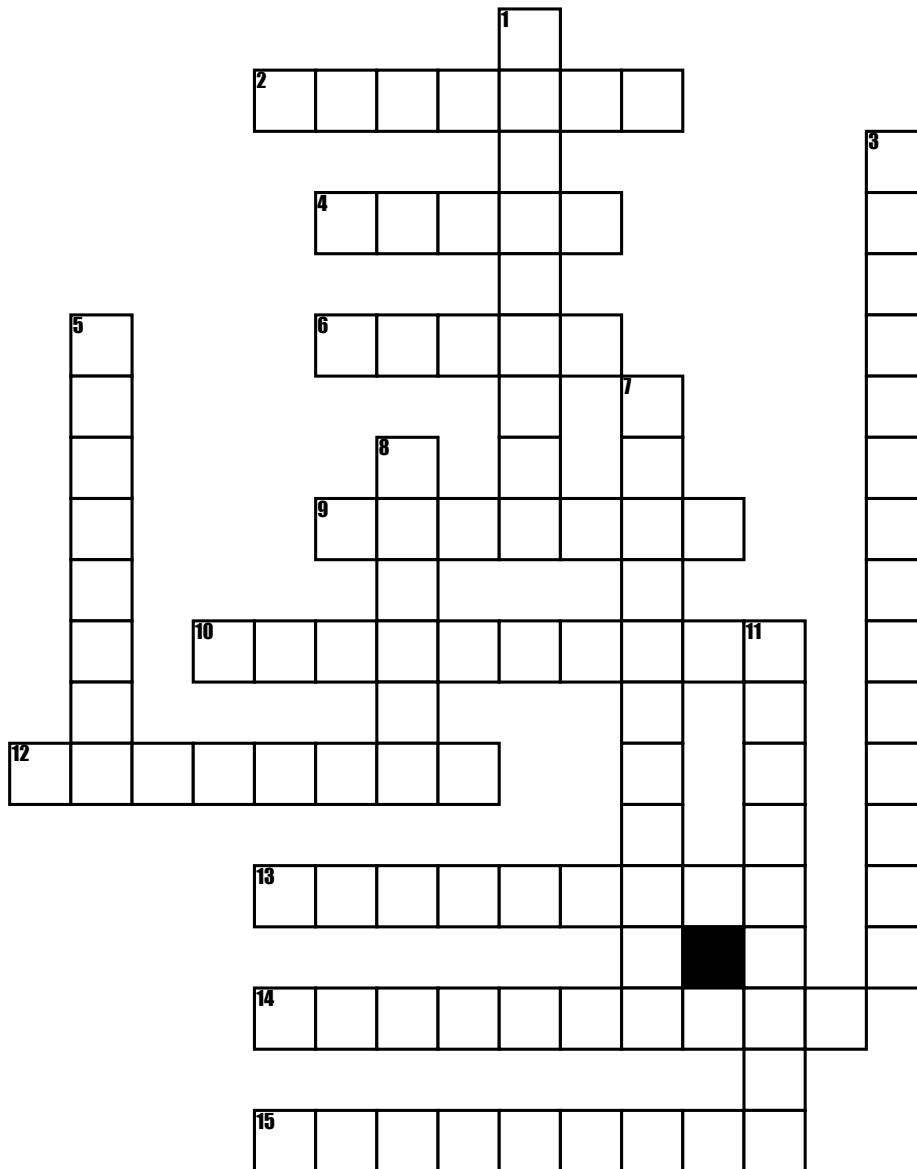


Night By Elie Wiesel
