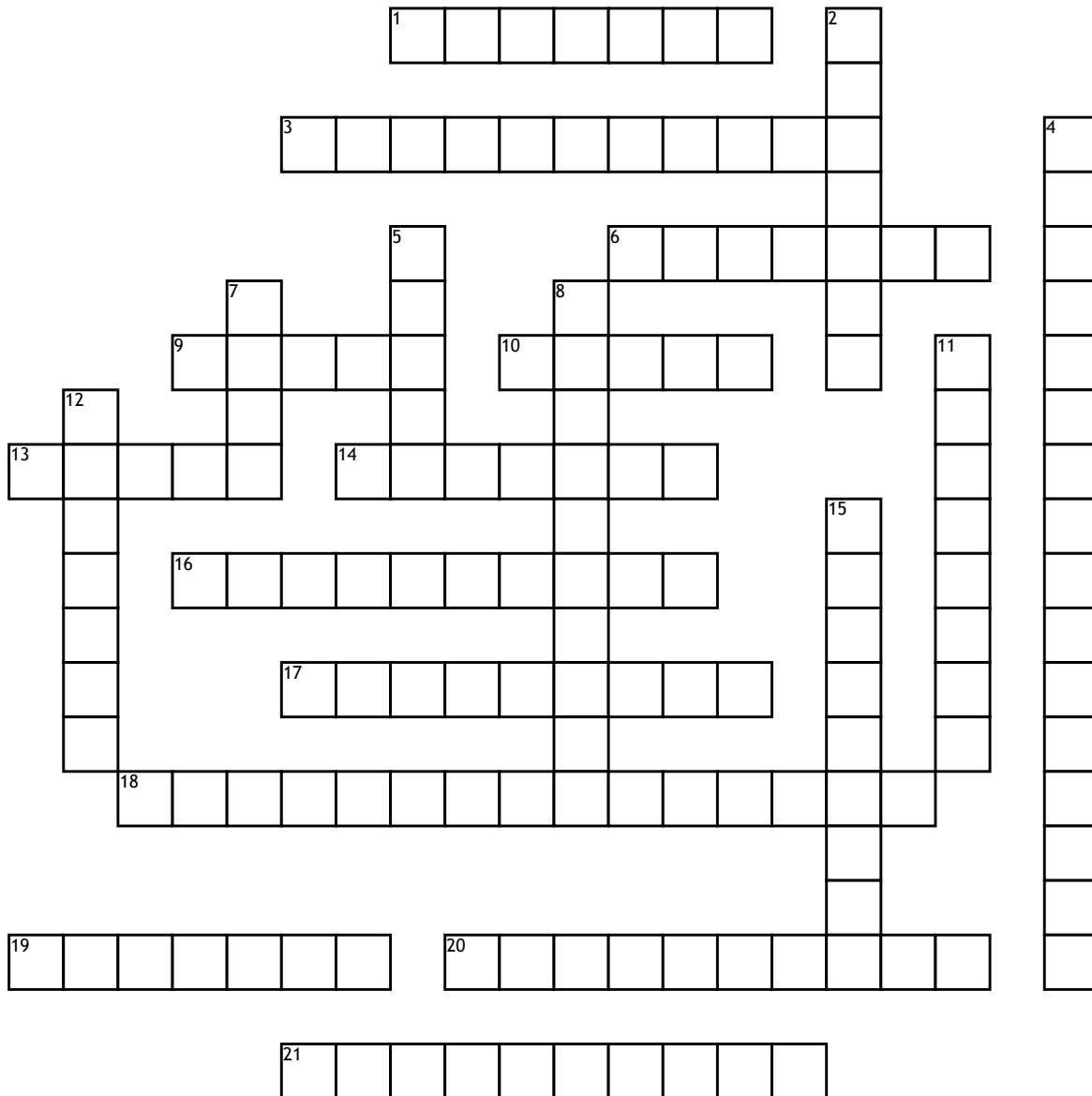


Night Crossword
