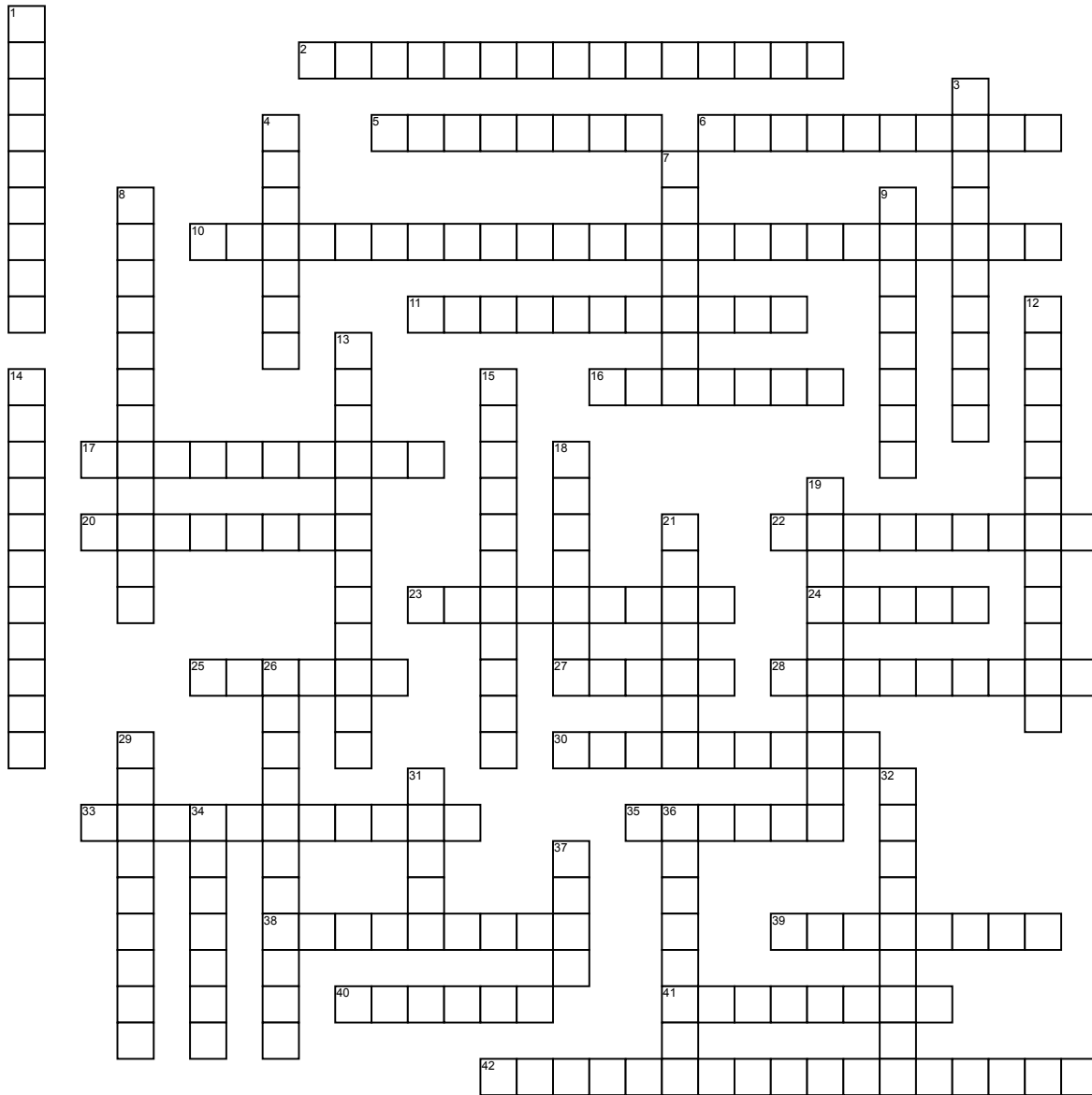


# Night Vocabulary Crossword
