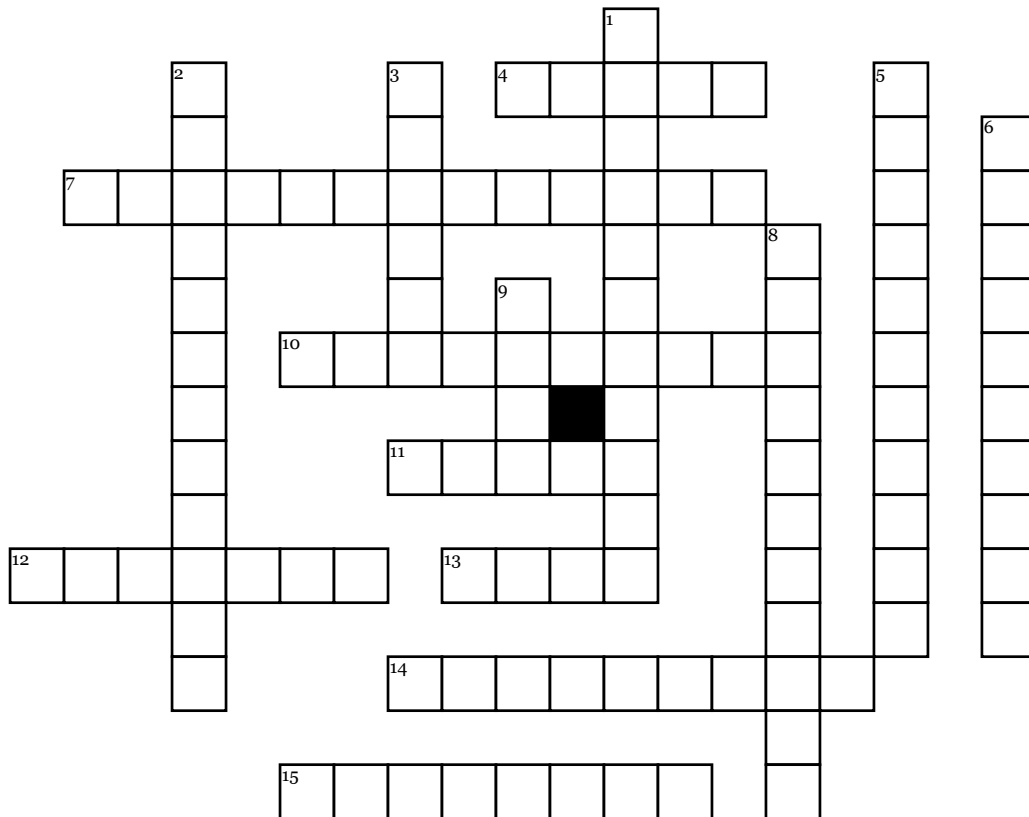


Night Vocabulary Crossword
