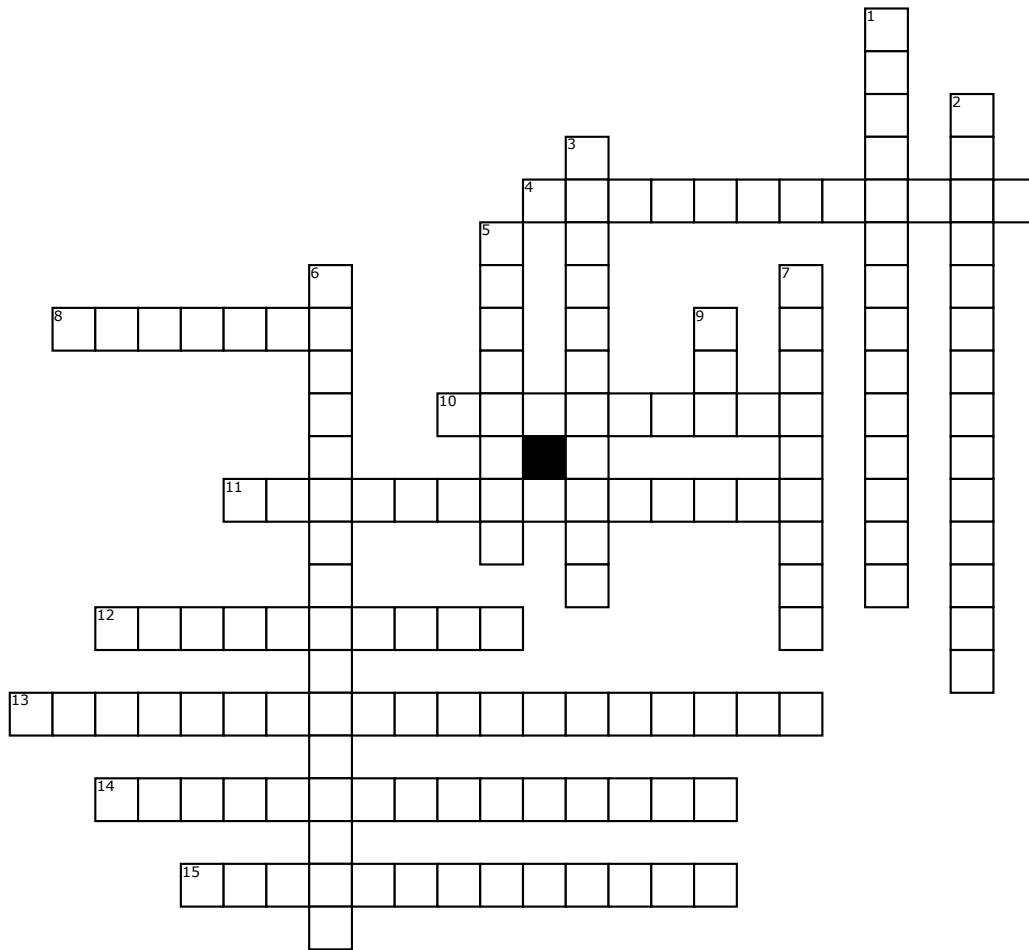


# Northwestern Africa

**5.** in Cairo...a warren of streets just bustling with life with mosques at every corner, Coptic churches, and bazaars

**6.** the pharaohs were mummified and buried in deep tombs along with their favorite pets and sacred artifacts here

**7.** in Egypt...since Victorian times, visitors have been attracted here for the two temples built for Pharaoh Ramesses II

**9.** in Morocco...was Morocco's capitol for more than 400 years and is still considered the religious and cultural center of the country today
