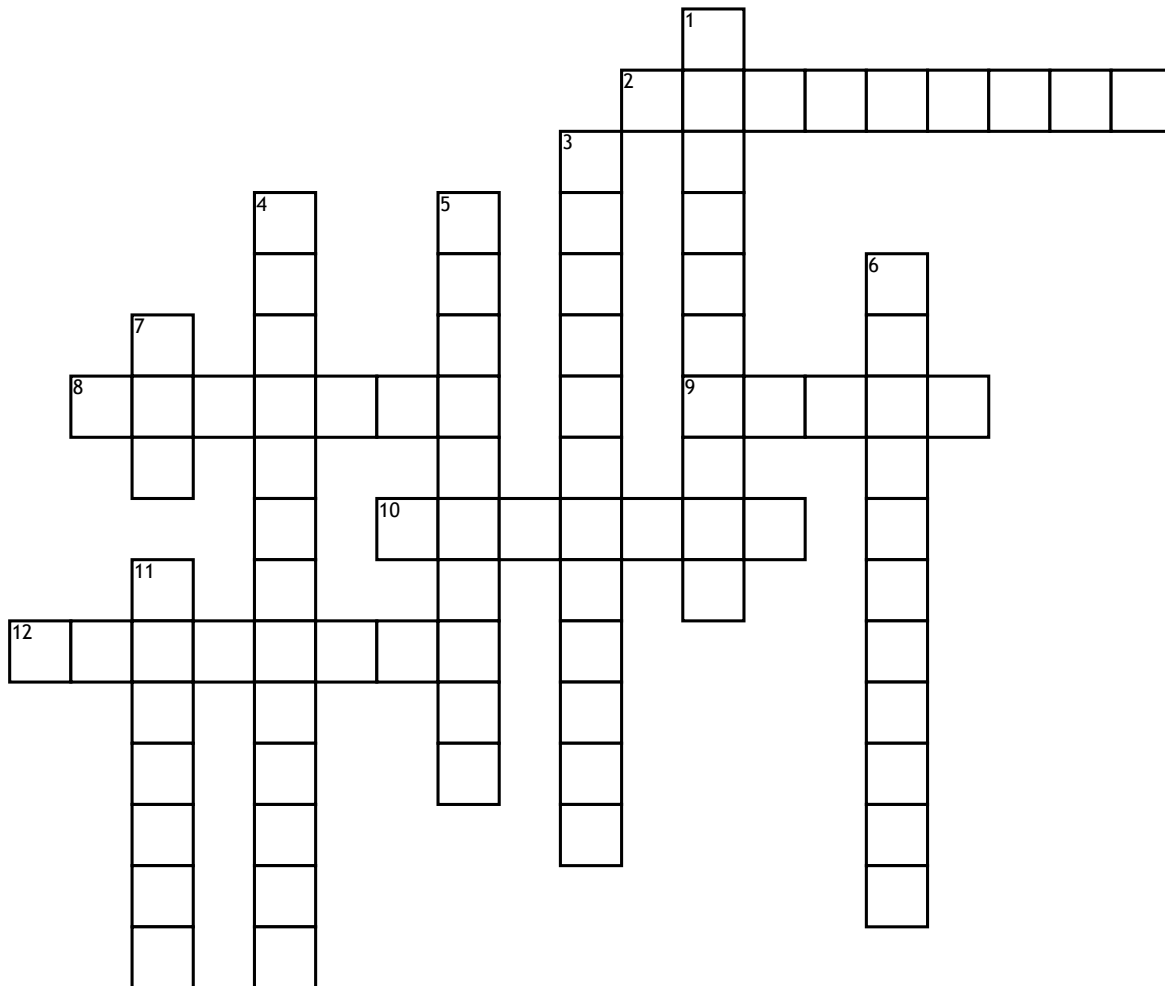

2. A coming to agreement among the parties, without an enforced decision or vote

9. Something that is created when one or more persons sign over assets to be held and managed by another person(s) for the benefit of a third person

10. The person who has contributed funds or property owned by them to a trust for administration and management by one or more trustees for the benefit of beneficiaries according to a trust agreement or trust deed

12. Favours a particular political party, or an individual candidate of a particular political party

1. A type of registered charity that primarily exists to distribute funds to qualified donees, although they could carry on their own charitable activities

3. The document forming an association, generally setting out the purpose of the association, particulars about the membership, and various rules

4. Those who are intended to receive a benefit, under the terms of a trust or a will

5. Where parties are not related in any way by blood, marriage, common law or business relationship

6. An unincorporated not-for-profit entity that is not a trust; an association usually officers, and a constitution that describes the classes of membership and the rules of governance

7. The abbreviation for a charitable corporation or non-charitable corporation that receives more than \$10,000 in a fiscal year in donations from persons who are not members, officers, employees, etc

11. The person in the trust who administers and manages the assets and property
