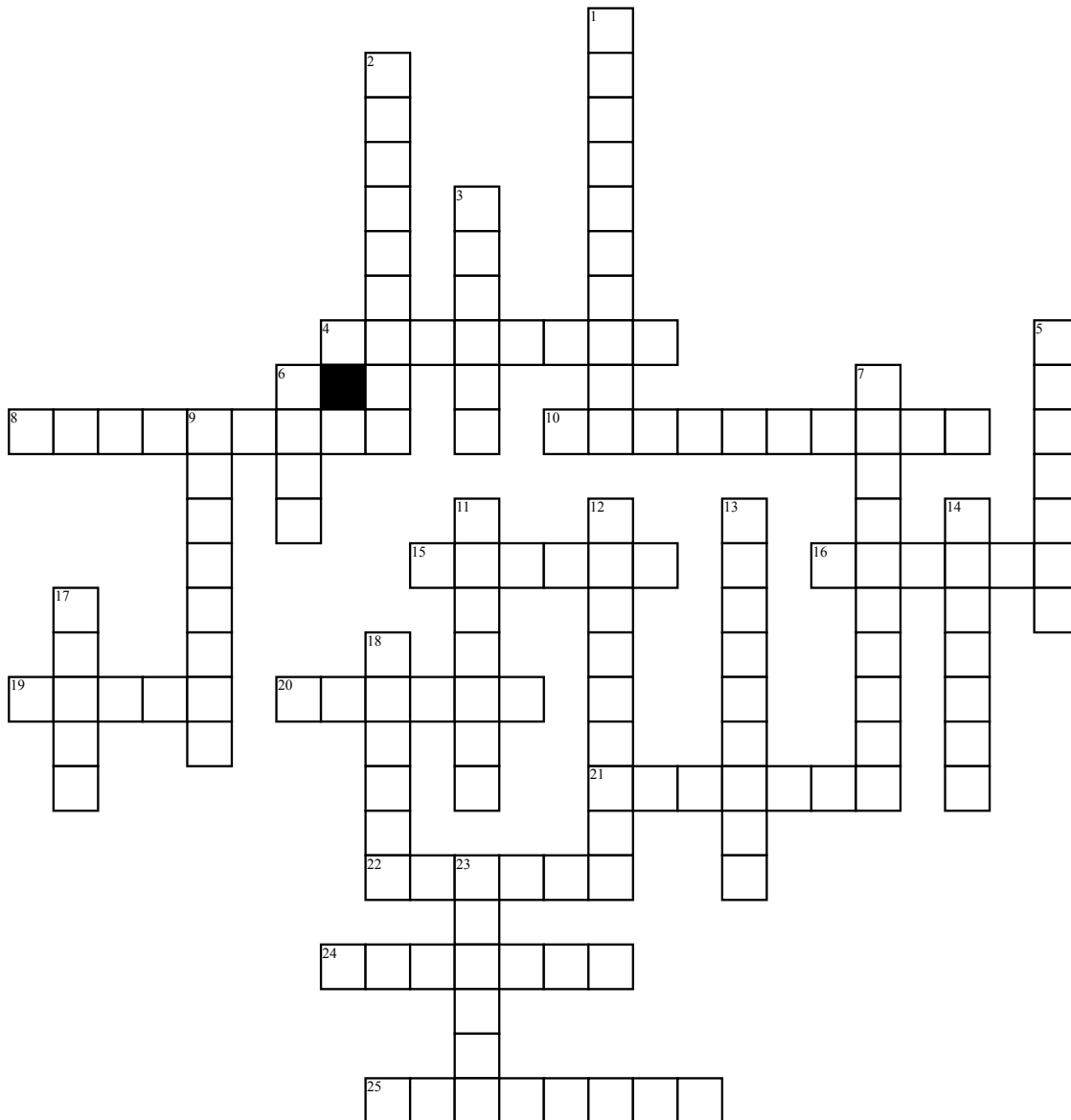


Noun/verb crossword puzzle
