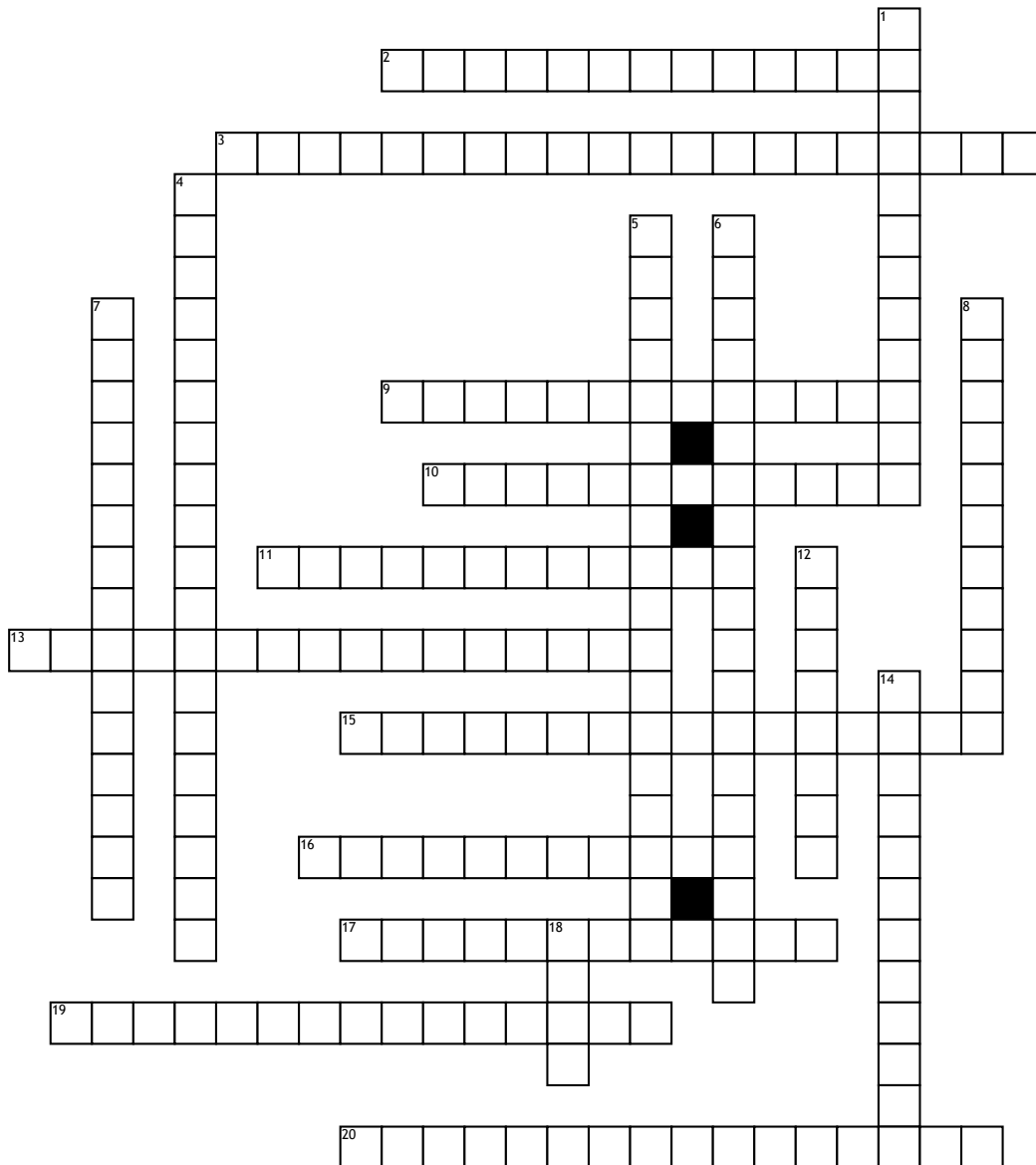

## Across

2. most common neck mass  
 3. unfused amnion  
 9. heart outside of the chest  
 10. absence of one or both eyes  
 11. abnormally small head  
 13. premature closure of the cranial sutures  
 15. dilation of the ventricles within the brain

16. more than one spleen  
 17. webbing of the fingers  
 19. destruction of the cerebral hemispheres by the occlusion of the internal carotid arteries, and fluid replaces cerebral tissue

20. Most common; unilocular or multilocular  
**Down**  
 1. enlarged tongue  
 4. herniation of abdominal viscera into chest

5. measurement done from 11 and 13 weeks, 6 days  
 6. Reduction in lung volume  
 7. blockage of the duodenal lumen  
 8. most common open neural tube defect  
 12. absence of a spleen  
 14. Abnormally large head  
 18. multicystic mass within the lung
