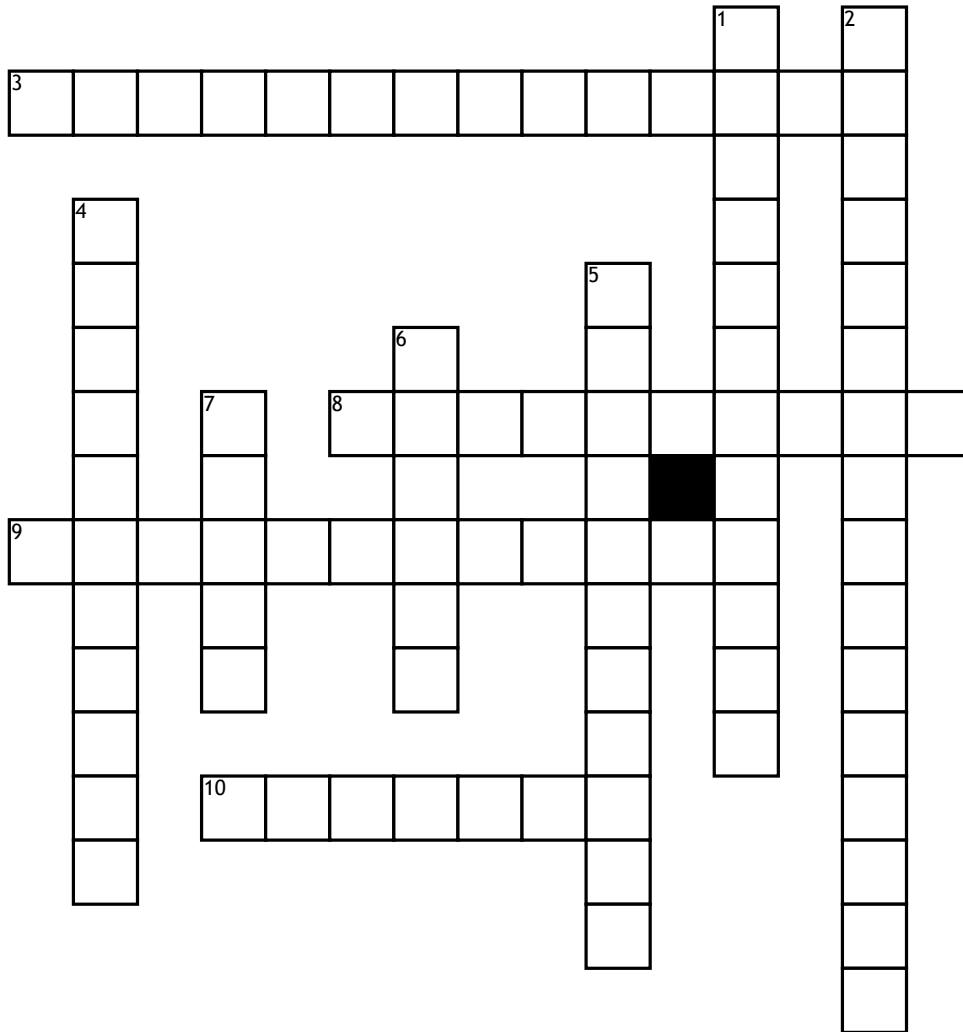


Observational Techniques

- 3. The researcher is not involved in the activity being observed in this type of observation
- 8. In this type of observation, behaviour is observed under conditions created by the researcher
- 9. Expectations of the researcher affect what they observe which reduces the validity of the observations (8,4)
- 10. This researcher carried out a controlled observation involving bobo dolls

- 1. This type of observation is carried out in an everyday setting and the investigator does not interfere, only observes
- 2. An example of an observational study in attachment (Ainsworth) (7,9)
- 4. Inter-observer _____ is when there is an agreement between observers of a behaviour
- 5. This type of observation includes the researcher involving themselves in the activity being observed
- 6. In this observation participants are unaware that they are being observed.
- 7. Participants are aware that their behaviour is being studied in this type of observation
