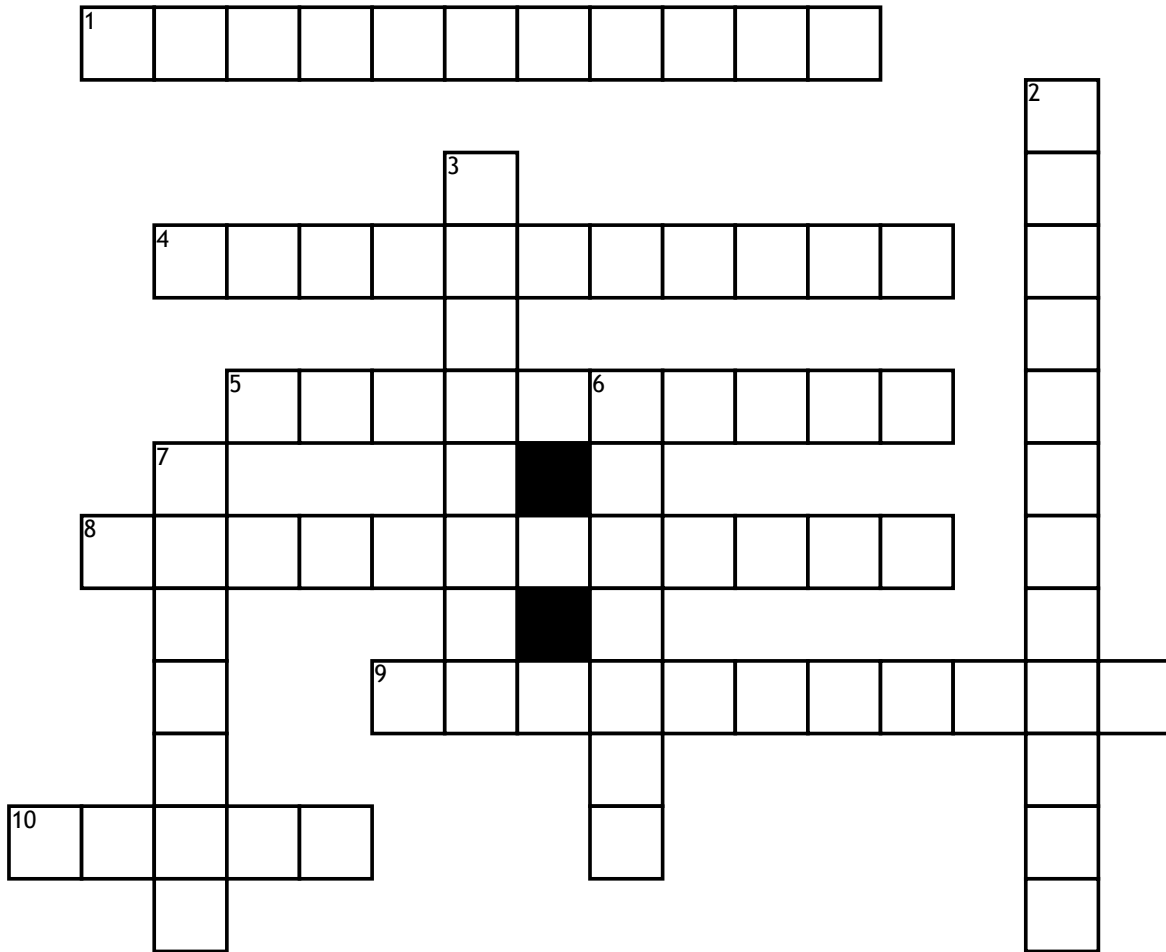


# Occupational Adaptation
