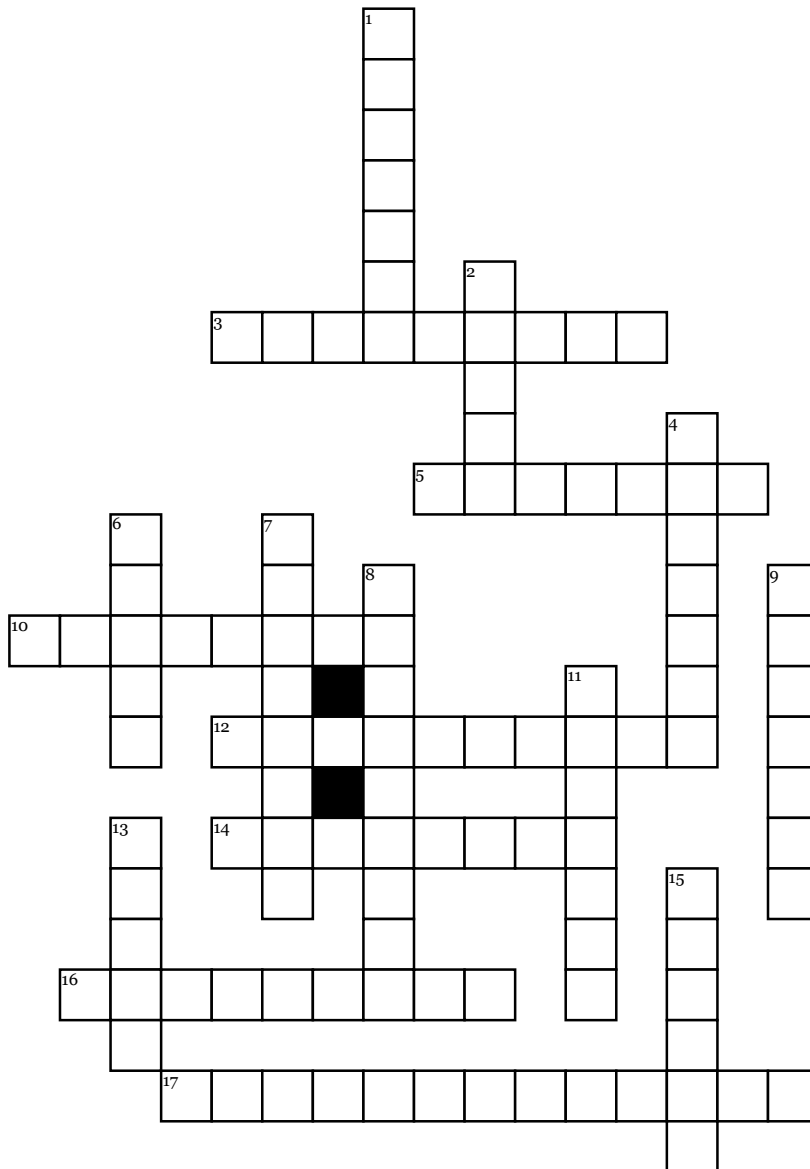


# Off To Sea



## Across

- 3.** Blue flag with white square in centre used as ship's signal
- 5.** Ship's chart indicating compass deflection due to ship's iron
- 10.** Case in which a ship's compass is kept
- 12.** Part of ship's stern where name is displayed
- 14.** Ring through which rope is led to change its direction without friction

**16.** Deck behind a ship's bridge

**17.** Hiring of a vessel

## Down

- 1.** Wood placed in bottom of ship to keep cargo dry
- 2.** To secure a rope by winding on a pin or cleat
- 4.** Upright device for winding in heavy ropes or cables
- 6.** Large jib that overlaps the mainsail

**7.** Stay extending from ship's mastheads to the side of the ship

**8.** Delay of vessel's departure or loading with cargo

**9.** Rib of a ship

**11.** Rounded wooden block with hole used to set up ship's stays

**13.** Toward or at the stern of a ship; further aft

**15.** To turn a ship on its side in order to clean or repair it
