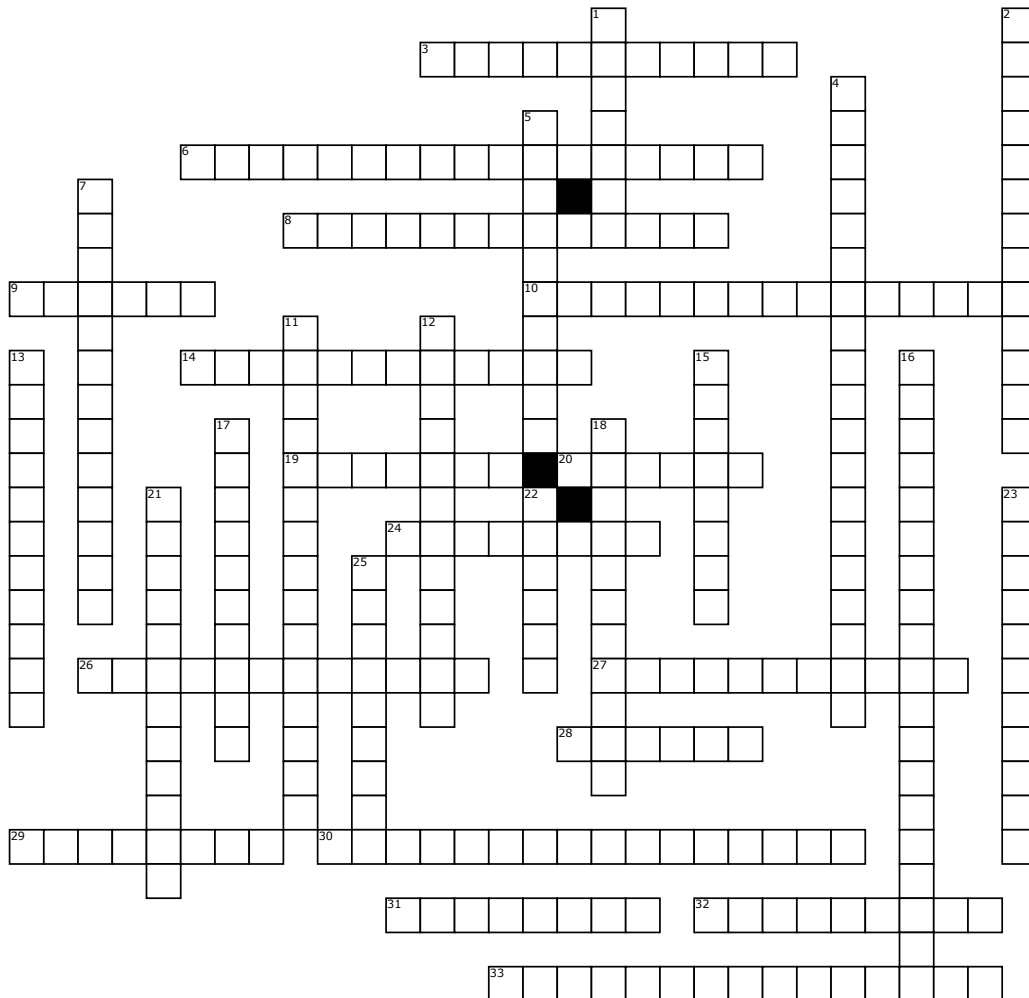

- 3.** Paralysis of the ciliary muscle
6. Attachment of the iris to the cornea
8. A potential space in the vitreous running from the optic disk to the lens
9. The term used to describe an absence of a pupil
10. Inflammation of the choroids and the retina
14. Irregular bodies on the papillary edges of the iris, very prominent in equines
19. The angle at either end of the eyelid aperture
20. Another term for eyelash
24. Oedema of the conjunctiva
26. The fluid that fills the anterior and posterior chamber of the eye
27. Enlargement of the globe due to chronic glaucoma
28. The collective term for the following structures: eyelids; third eyelid; conjunctiva; lacrimal glands and orbital content.
29. An opacity of the lens and/or lens capsule
30. Small refractile bodies in the vitreous which do not settle when the eye is moved

- 31.** A congenital fissure or cleft of any part of the eye or eyelids
32. Granuloma of the tarsal gland
33. The fusion of the eyelid margins

- 1.** The absence of the lens
2. Spasm of the orbicularis oculi muscle
4. A remnant of the hyaloid artery in the center of the optic disc
5. Difference in size between the two pupils
7. The adjustment of the eye for seeing different distances which is accomplished by changing the shape of the lens
11. The visible crescent between the iris and the lens equator due to the subluxation of the lens
12. The absence of the eye
13. Inflammation of the eyelids
15. A small piece of skin in the medial canthus
16. Barrier between the vascular system and the aqueous, formed by the tight junctions between non-pigmented epithelial cells of the ciliary body and the endothelial cells of the iris capillaries

- 17.** Incision of the canthus, enlarging the palpebral opening
18. A portion of the uveal tract, between the iris and the choroids. It is responsible for the production of aqueous humor
21. Tyndell effect observed in the anterior chamber, with a beam of light when excessive protein is present in the aqueous. Pathognomonic for uveitis
22. The transparent portion of the outer coat of the eyeball
23. The mucous membrane lining the posterior surface of the eyelids and the anterior portion of the sclera
25. The term used to describe blindness of unknown etiology
