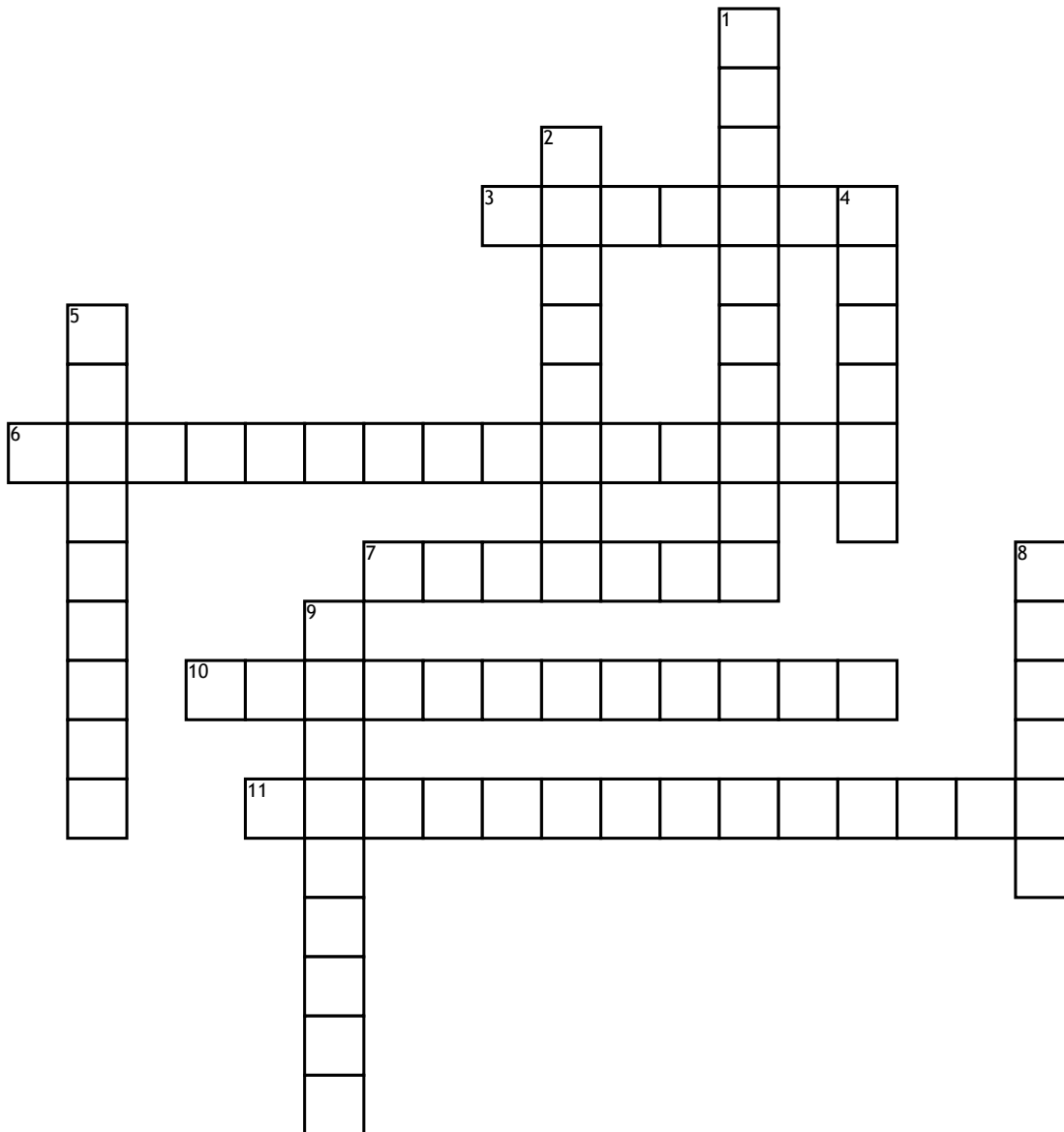

- 6. Debridement of the tooth socket or diseased tissue
- 7. Limited opening of the mouth
- 10. Similar to a hemostat and functions in much the same manner
- 11. Irrigation of the joints

- 1. Most common complication following an extraction, also know as dry socket

- 2. Trims and shaped alveolar bone after extractions
- 4. Thin wire used to clear blood and tissue from the surgical tips
- 5. Used to prevent the patient's mouth from closing during the procedure
- 8. Removal of tissue from a suspicious area to examine and diagnosis
- 9. Used to deflect tissue from the surgical site so that the view is unobstructed
