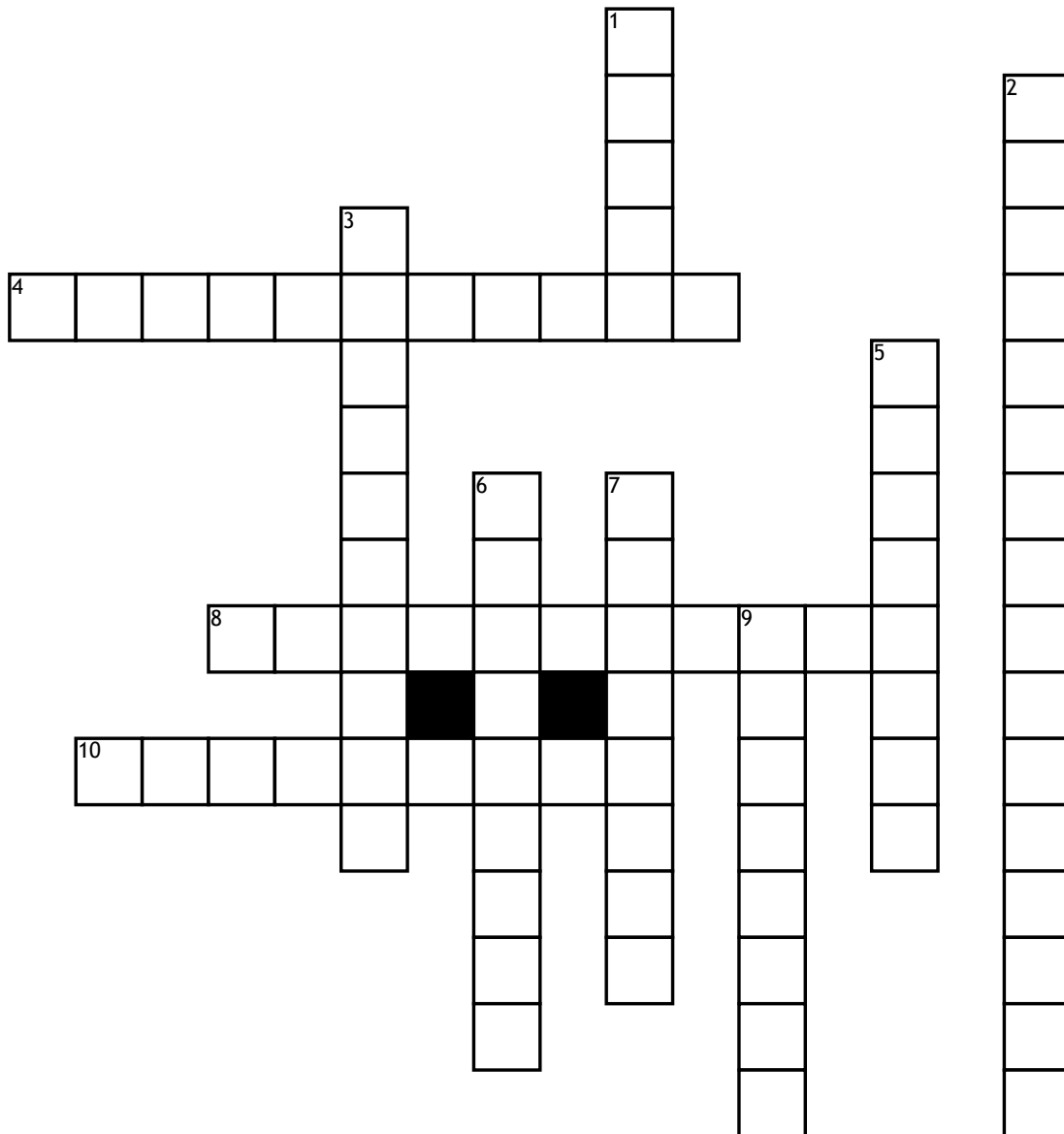

1. The junction between the ends of two adjacent bones that allows for movement.

2. Any fracture in which the overlying skin has been penetrated.

3. A fracture that disrupts only one side of the bone.

5. A generic term that encompasses all metallic implants.

6. A cellular tissue that, in the adult, is specific to joints, but in children forms a template for bone formation and growth.

7. Healing of a fracture in an unacceptable position.

9. Any surgically placed, non-biological material whose purpose is to promote healing of tissues or serve as a replacement of structures such as joints.
