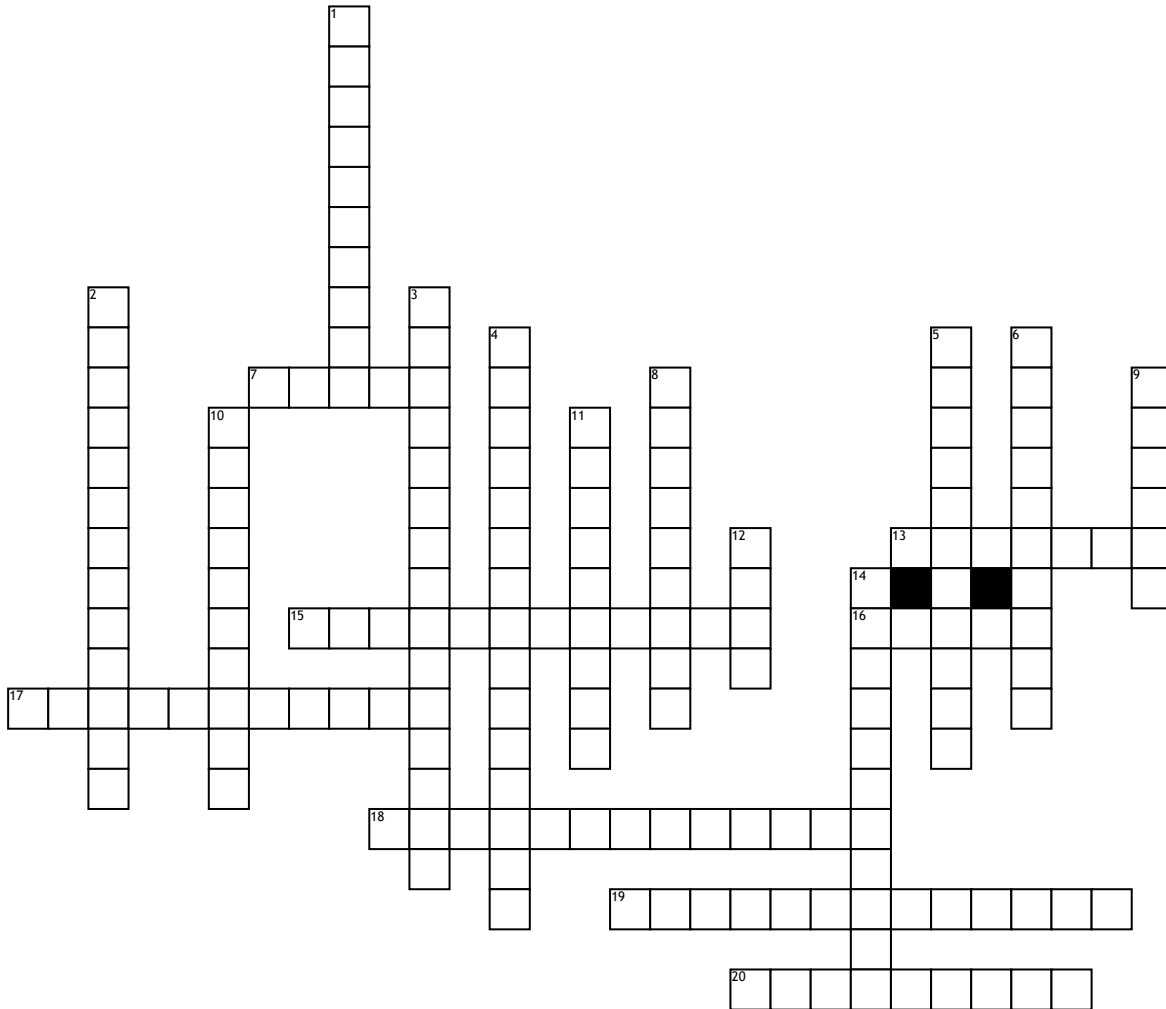


Our Ecological Footprint
