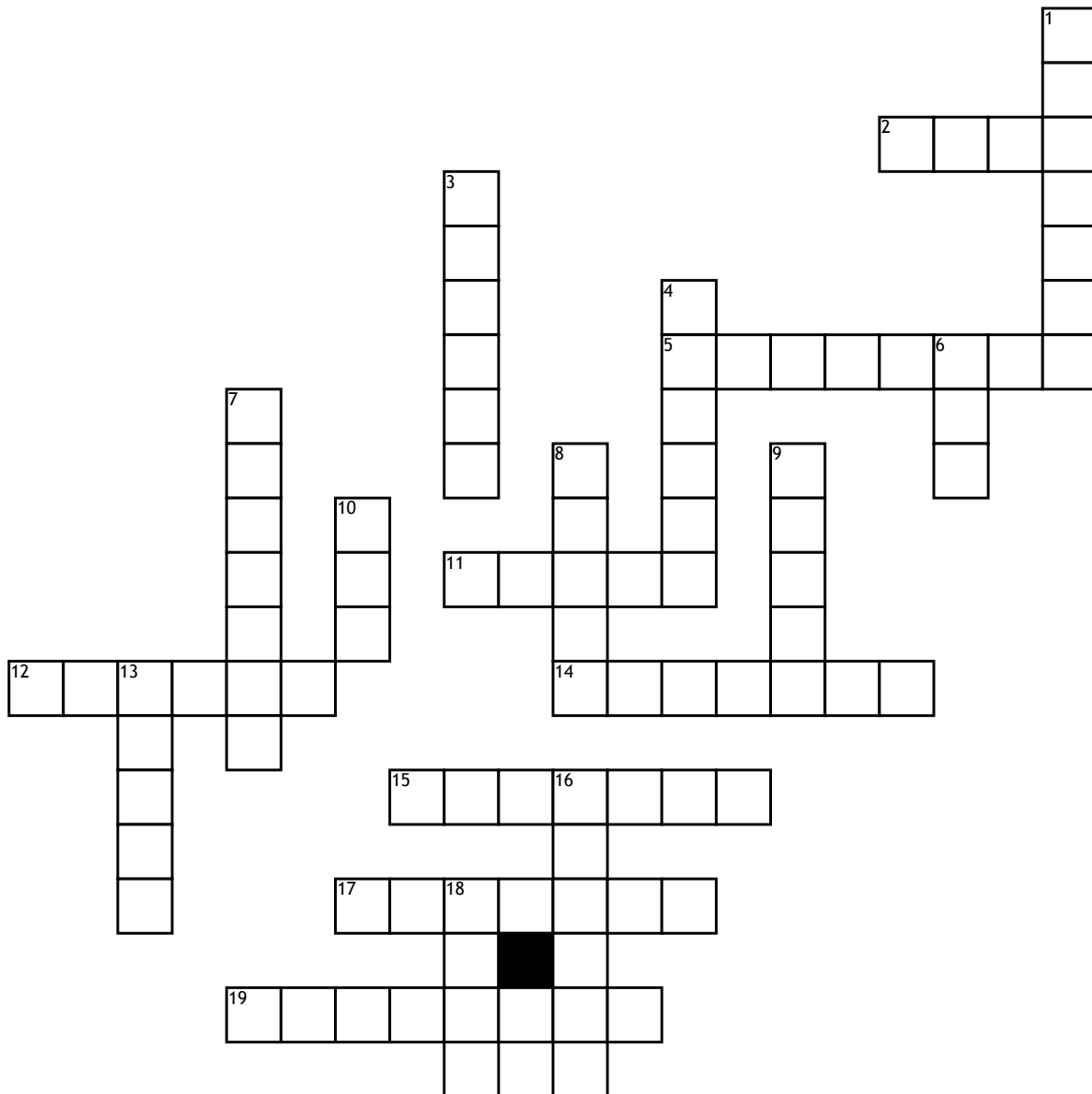


PAST TENSE VERBS: Use the past form of the verb in parantheses.
