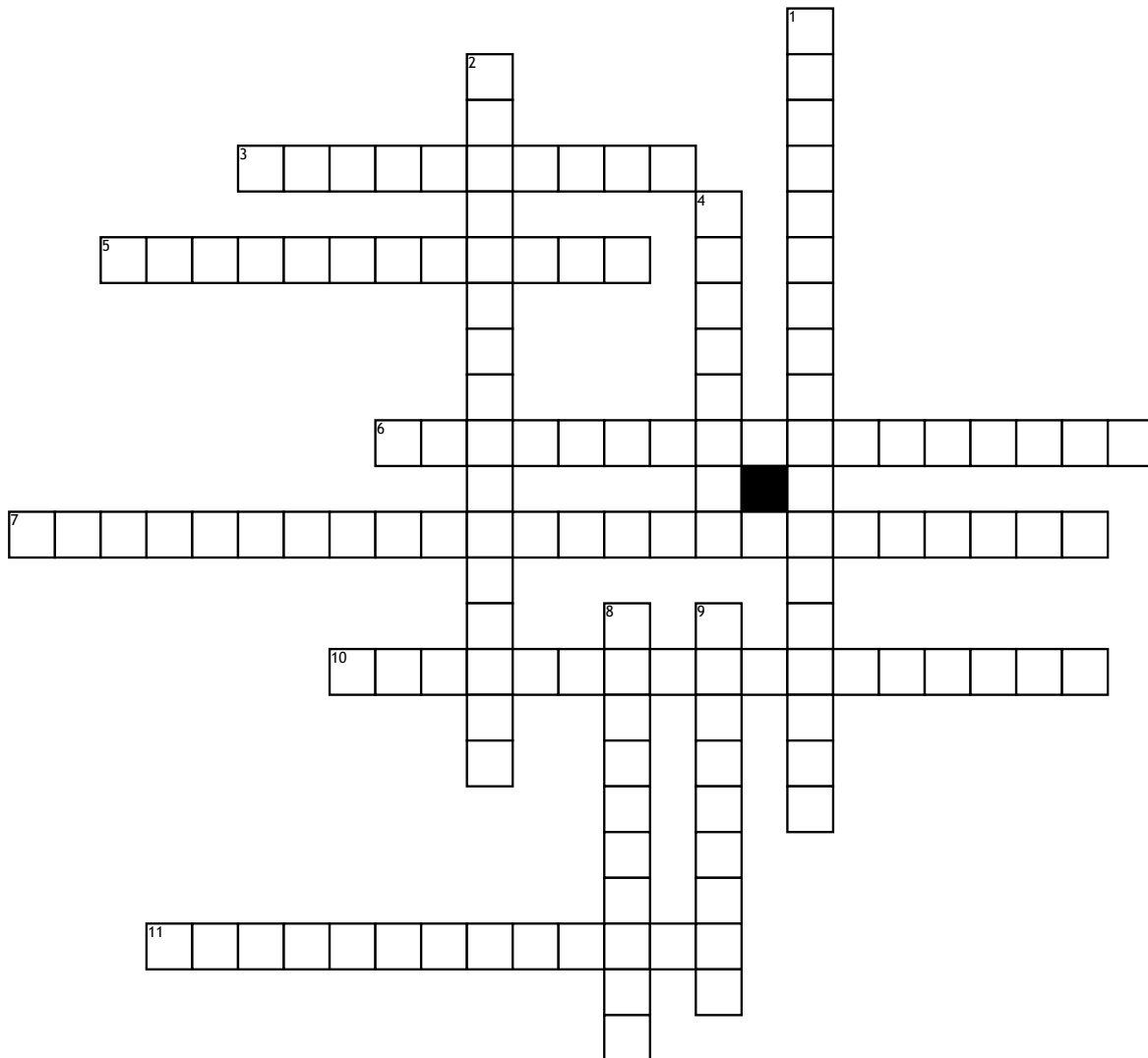

- 5. occurs when people base their choices on how close a candidate's issues positions are to their own issue preferences.

- 7. the belief that the election winner has a mandate to implement policy promises.
- 10. a requirement that citizens register to vote before the election is held.
