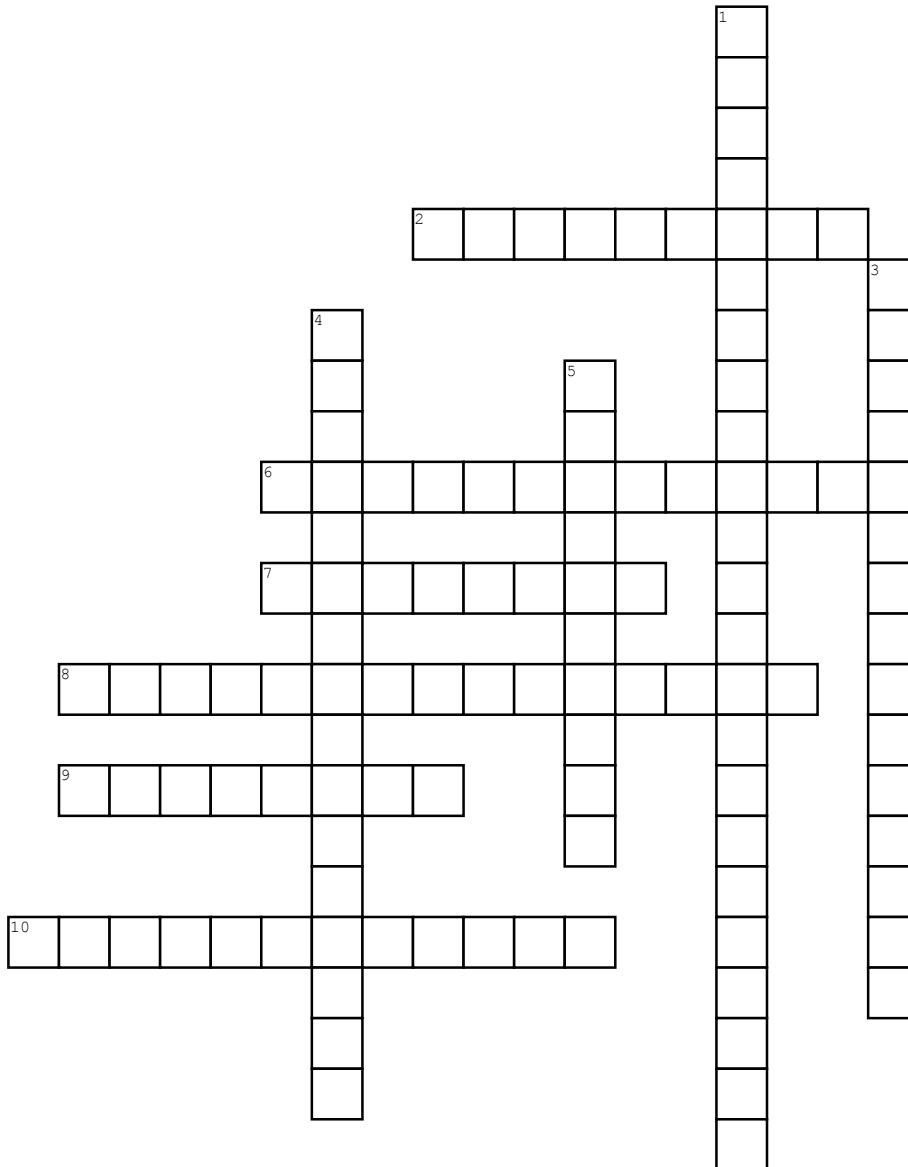

- 2. Worn from the waist to the ankles, covering both legs separately
- 6. protecting the foot and leg from water, extreme cold, mud or hazards
- 7. worn around the lower back to provide support to the lumbar.
- 8. used for uniforms of the police or military, as well as for protection in industrial settings such as mining and construction.
- 9. worn to protect against allergens.

- 10. mainly cover the foot and the ankle, while some also cover some part of the lower calf.
