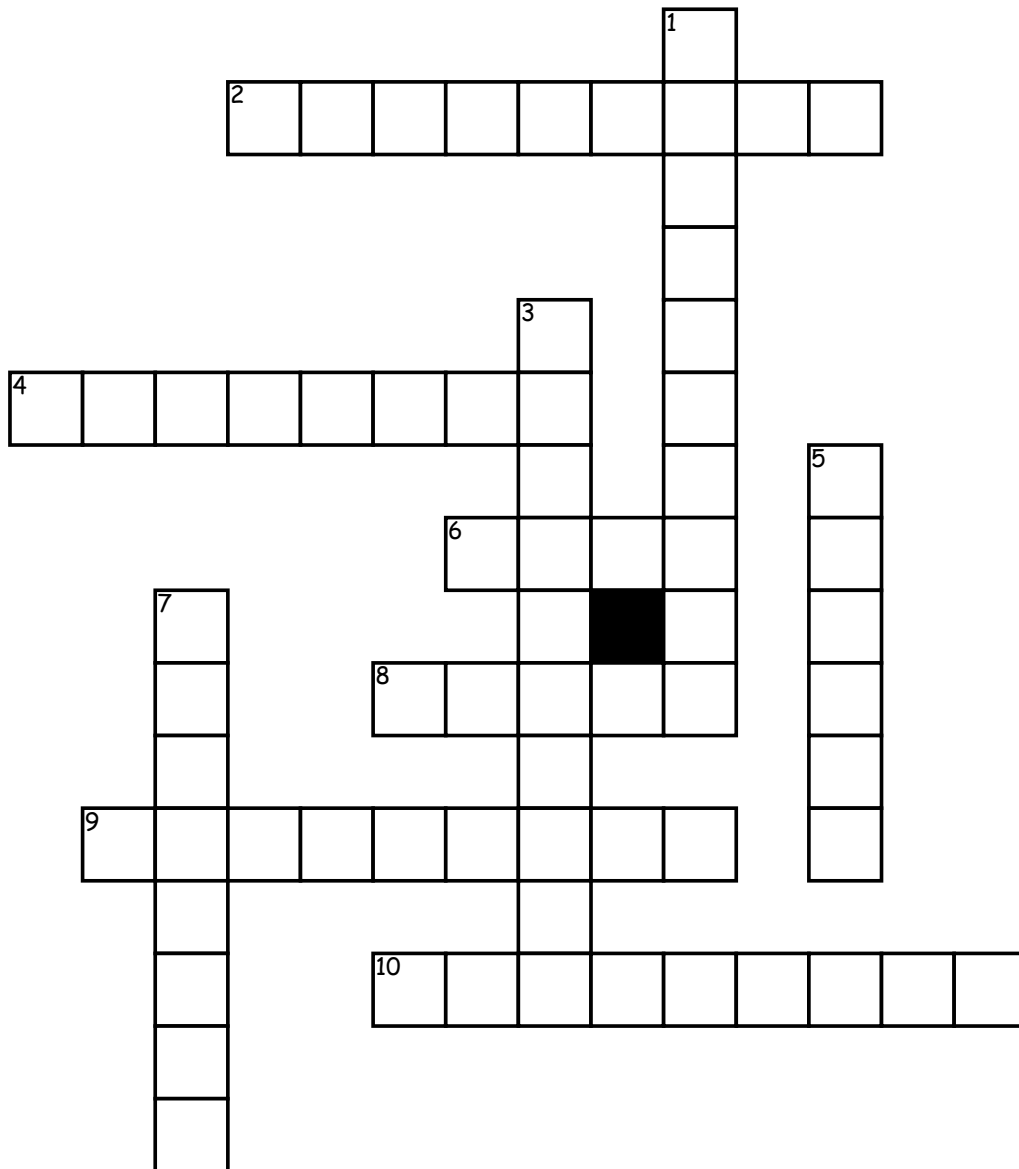


# P.P.R.E Crossword
