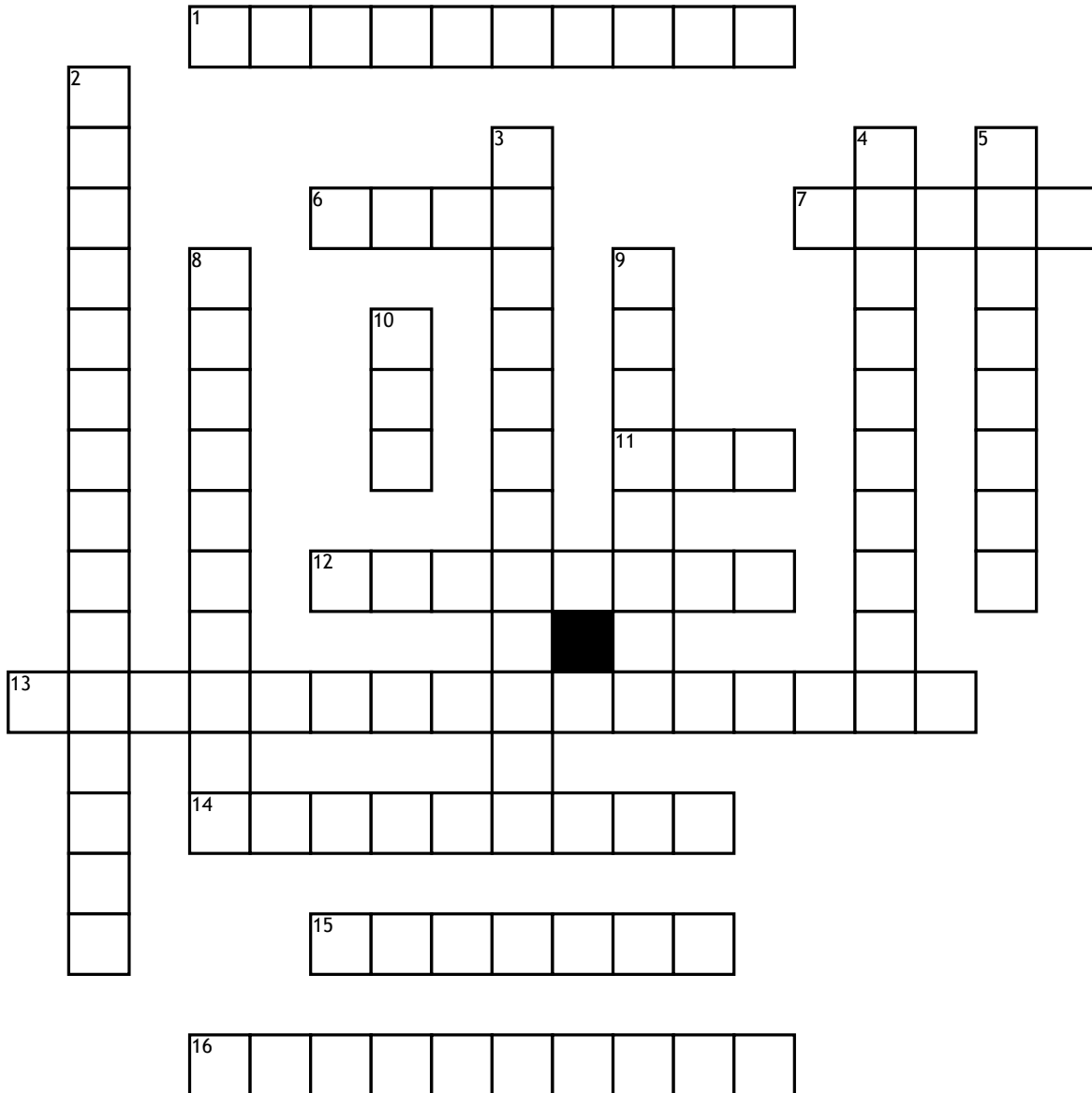


PREOPERATIVE PHASE

- 7. Surgical alteration minimal, low risk to life of patient
- 11. Preoperative blood test

- 14. Unanticipated surgery, done immediately to preserve life of patient, body part, or body function
