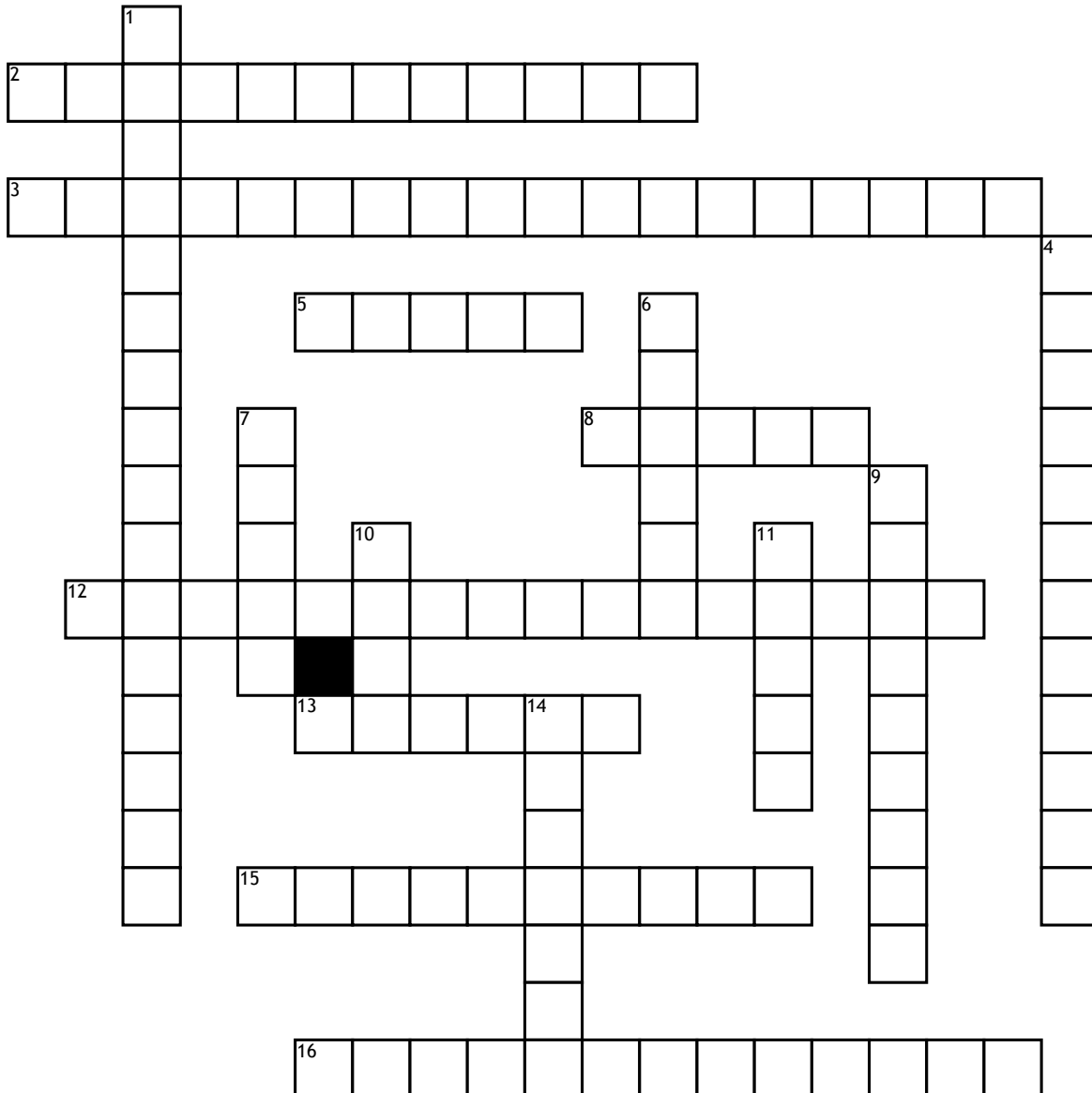


Parliamentary Procedure
