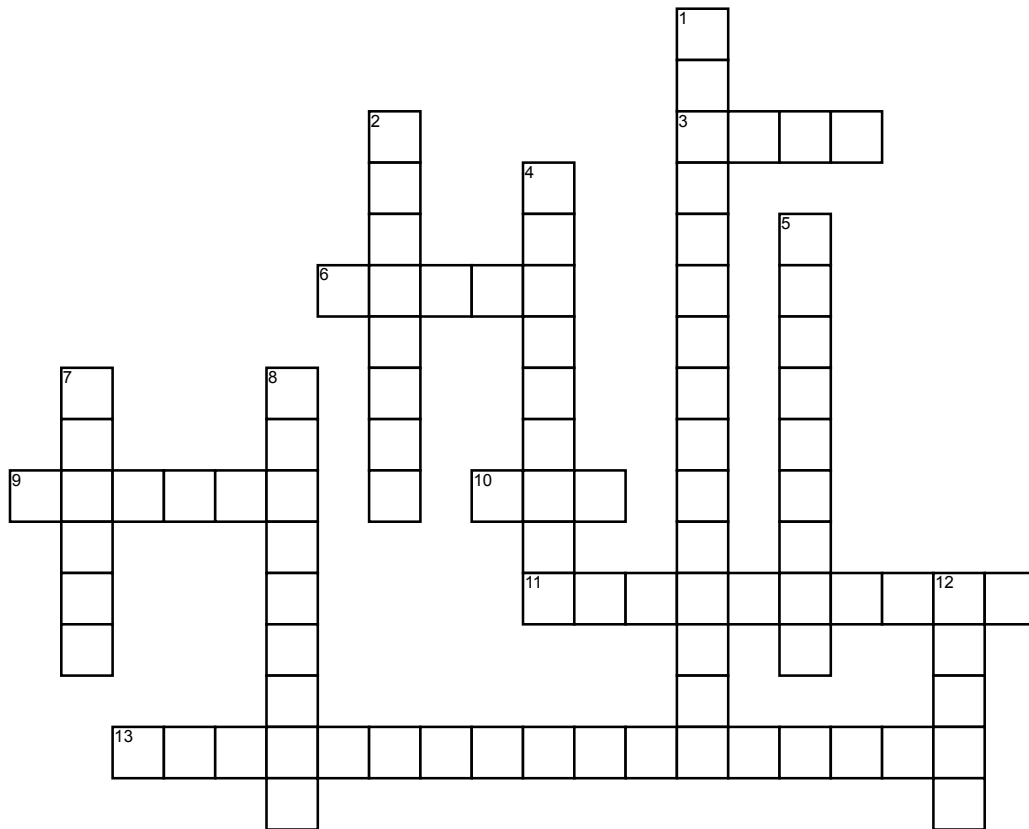


(Part Two) Persons Unknown Crossword Puzzle
