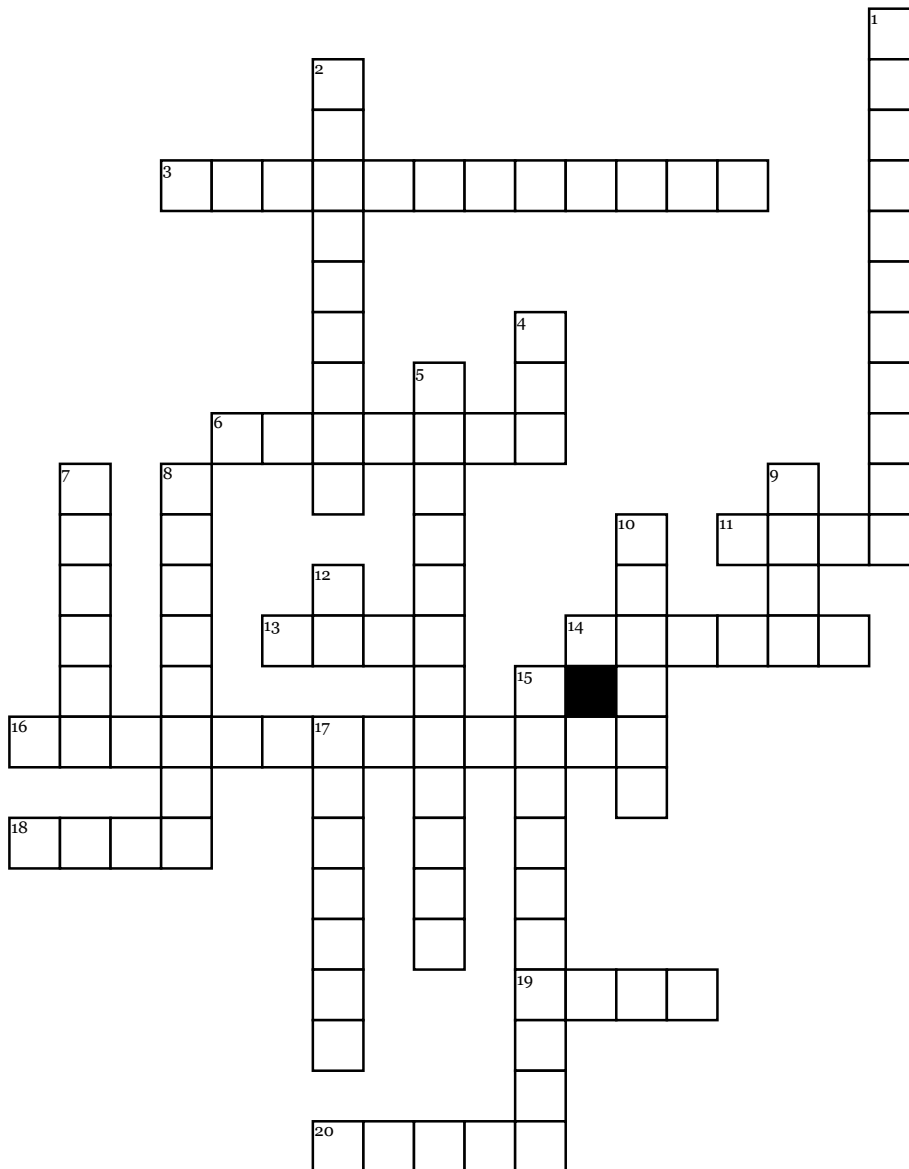


Parts Of Speech Crossword Puzzle
