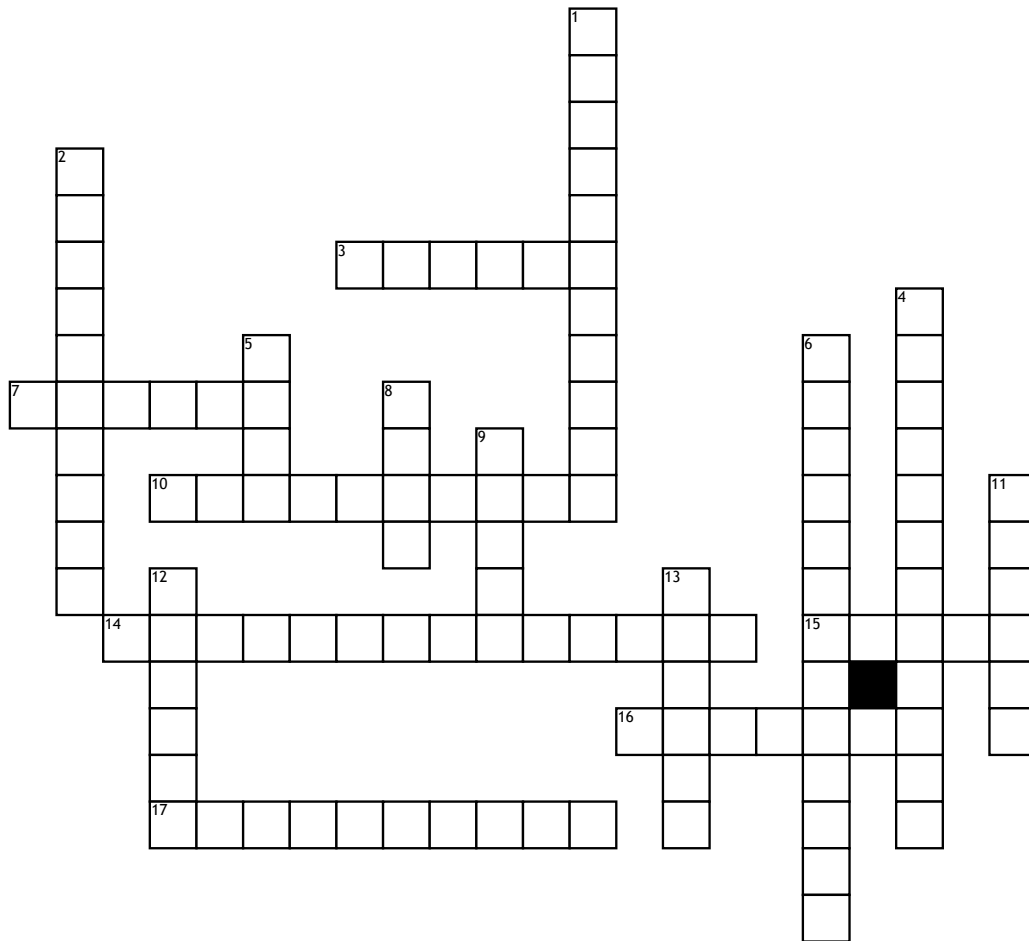


# Parts of Western Saddle



**Across**

- 3. Right below the horn
- 7. Accessory button looking things made out of metal
- 10. Piece of leather that you use to tighten down the cinch and saddle
- 14. Long leather strap to connect the back cinch to the saddle
- 15. The part of the saddle that you should grab when mounting a horse.
- 16. The thing you put your foot in
- 17. Large piece of leather below the cantle

**Down**

- 1. The piece of tack that connects the cinch on the right side of the horse
- 2. Flap of leather that goes right under your thigh
- 4. Flap of leather that can hold extra long latigo.
- 5. Where the rains can go over to keep from falling down the horse's neck.
- 6. Strings that are used as decorations or tying things to the saddle

- 8. The part of the saddle you sit directly on
- 9. The main piece of tack that secures the saddle to the horse
- 11. Where the saddle blanket should be pulled up into when saddling.
- 12. Flap of leather that lays between your leg & the horse
- 13. The part of the saddle that is right behind you when you are sitting
