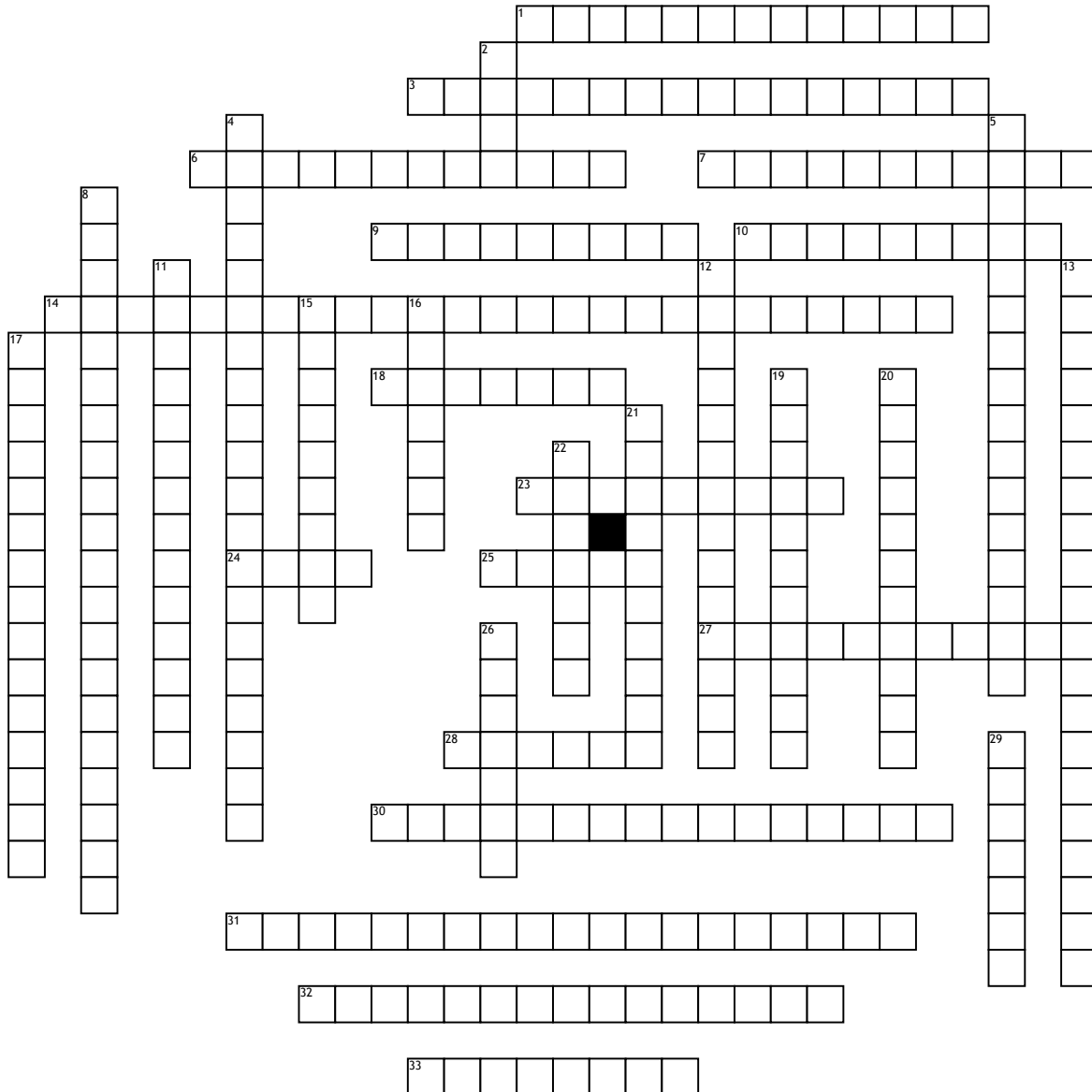


# Parts of the Courtroom
