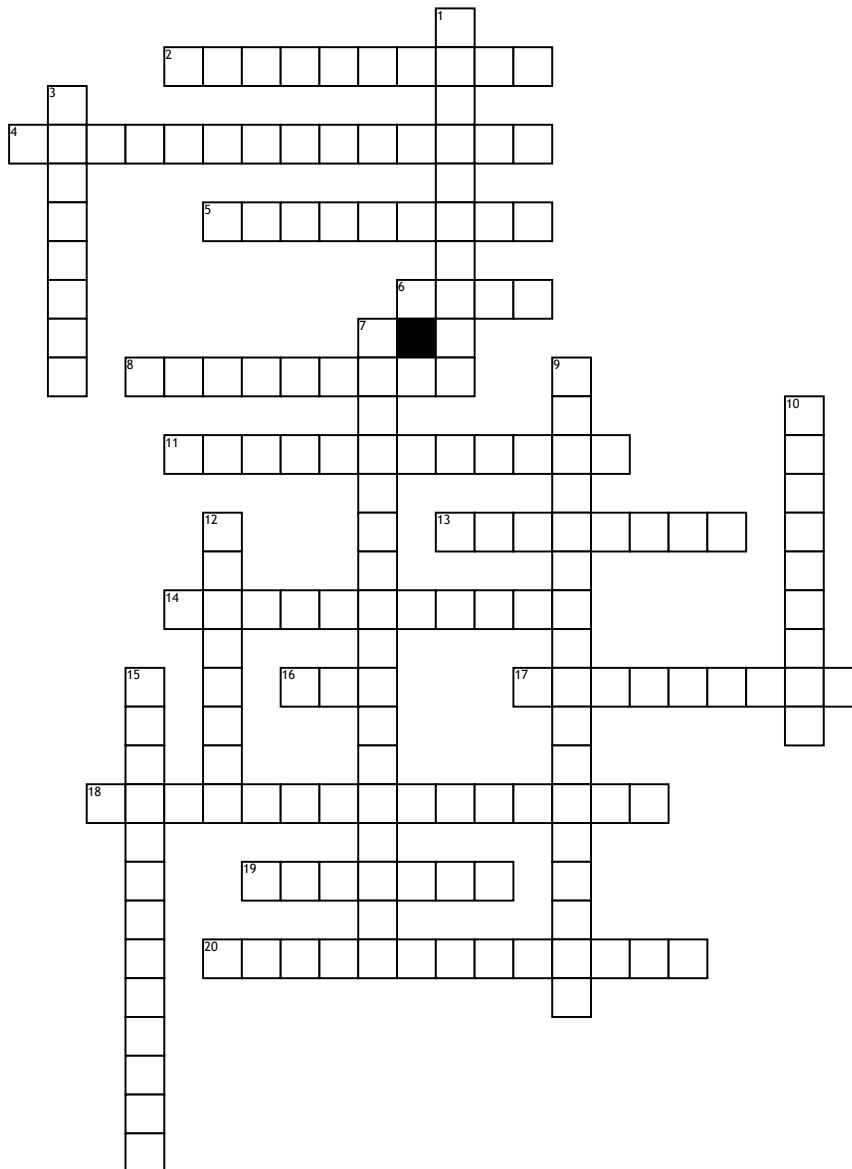


# Passion of Christ

2. The priest in charge of the Temple worship. The high priest shared in the general priestly duties.
4. The high priest at the time of Jesus' crucifixion.
5. The crime of insulting God or of claiming Godlike attributes

16. Abbreviates the Latin words meaning "Jesus of Nazareth, King of the Jews"; an inscription over the cross that advertises Jesus' crime. Jesus accepts Pilate's charge that he is the "King of the Jews".
17. applies to a person who bears witness to the truth of his or her faith even unto death.
18. How did Jesus show us the depth of God's love?
19. Mary, the sister of Lazarus, anoints Jesus' head with expensive oil at \_\_\_\_\_
20. Pilate releases Jesus' body to Joseph of Arimathea. Joseph wraps Jesus' body in a clean linen cloth and places it in a new tomb in the rock. - A guard is posted at the tomb to guard against Jesus' disciples stealing the body and claiming that he rose from the dead.

1. Jesus prays in agony in the Garden of \_\_\_\_\_: "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from me; yet, not as I will, but as you will" (Matt 26:39). - Judas leads an armed crowd to arrest Jesus. All his disciples abandon Jesus at the time of his arrest.
3. Word means "place of the skull"; site where Jesus was crucified.
7. A wealthy disciple of Jesus and a member of the Sanhedrin who did not approve of the council's condemnation of Jesus. He wrapped Jesus' body in clean linen and placed him in a new tomb in the rock.
9. The name for the four separate accounts of the Passion of Christ found in the Gospels.
10. applies to a person who bears witness to the truth of his or her faith even unto death.
12. A criminal released by Pilate to the crowd, instead of Jesus, as part of a Passover custom.
15. betrays Jesus for thirty pieces of silver
