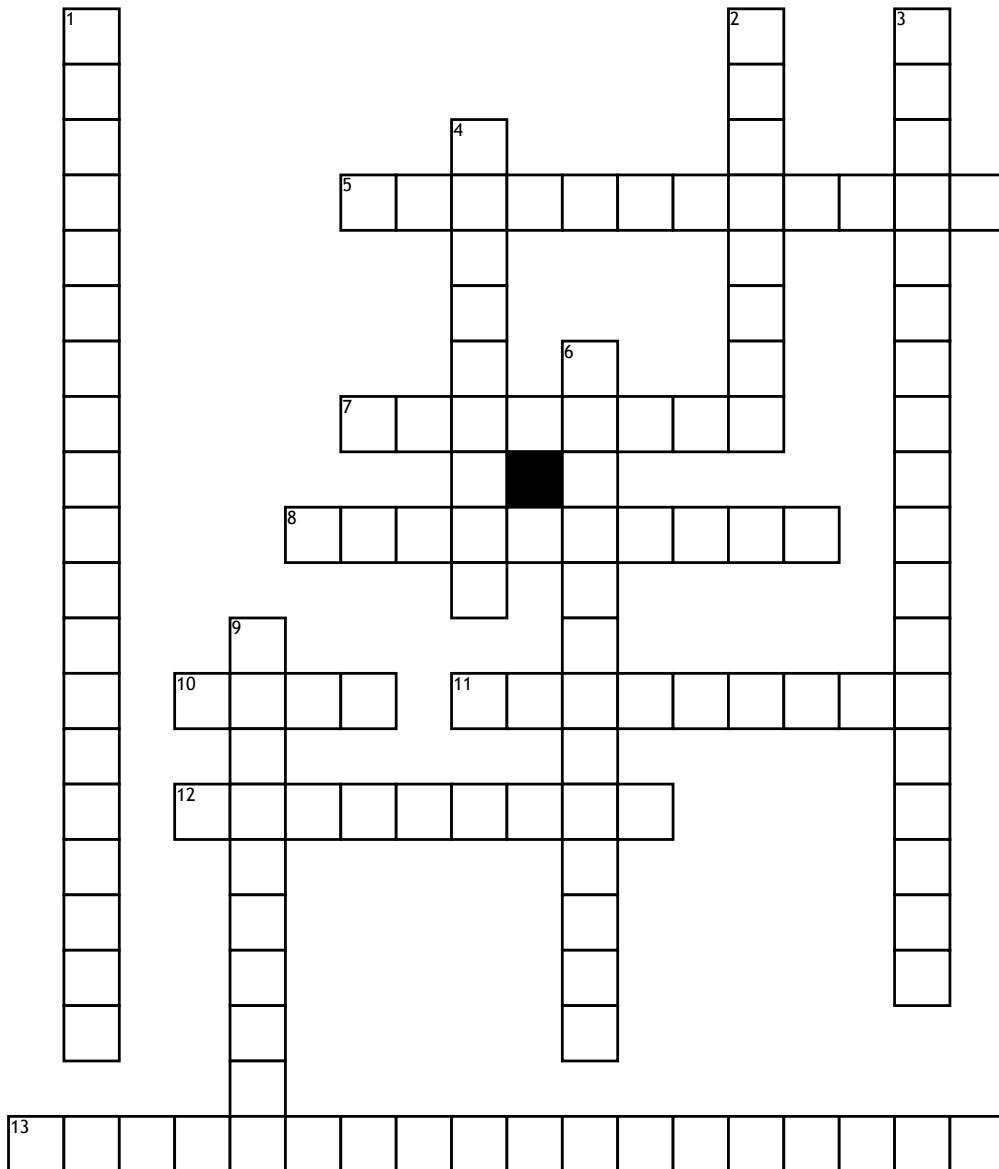

8. Acute inflammation of the upper respiratory tract mucosa, usually confined to the nose and throat
