1. A structured assessment tool that allows you to rapidly form a general impression without touching the pediatric patient
 2. Child 12 to 18 years of age
 3. First year of life
 4. Child 3 to 6 years of age
 5. Child 1 to 3 years of age
 6. Drawing in of the muscles between the ribs or sternum during inspiration
 7. High-Pitched inspiratory sound; indicates a partial upper airway obstruction
 8. Viral infection of the airway below the level of the vocal cords
 9. Bacterial infection of the soft tissue in the area above the vocal cords
 10. A communicable disease caused by a bacterium that is spread through respiratory droplets; Also known as whooping cough
