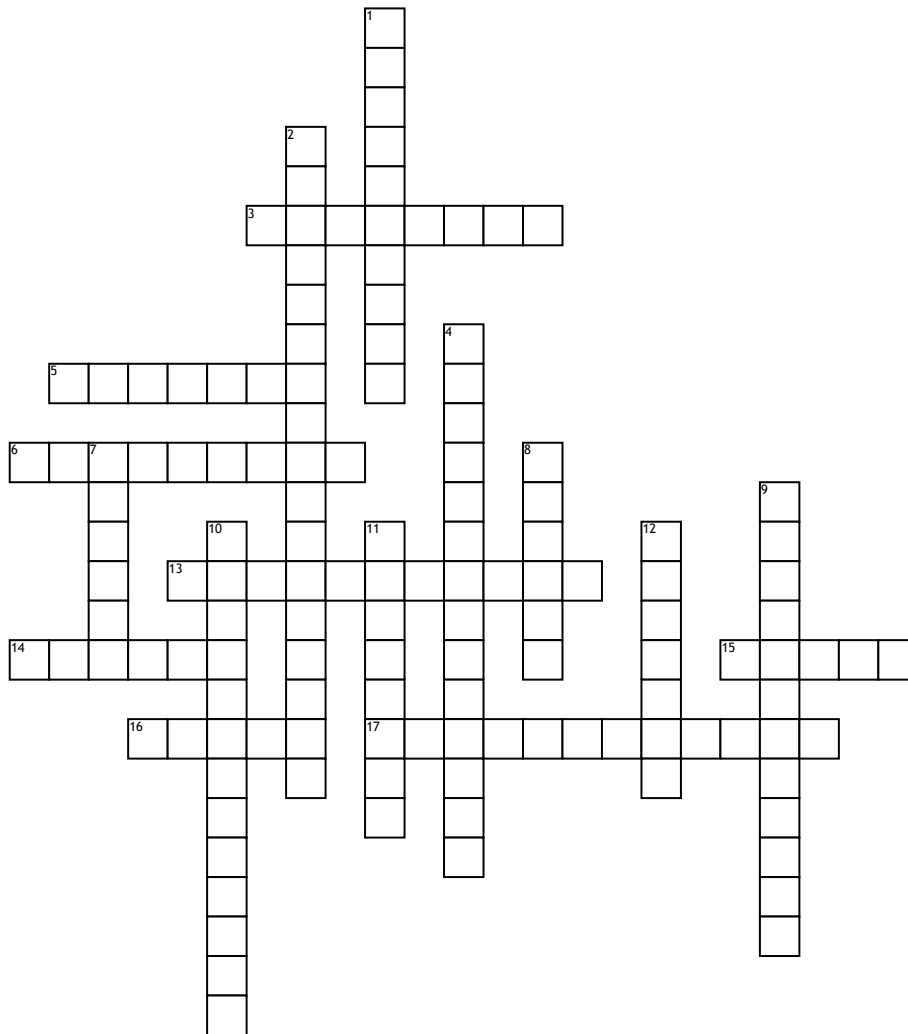


# Pediatrics Overview: Growth and Development of the Newborn and Infant

3. Reflex that results in fanning and hyperextension of toes  
 5. Grasp where the infant reflexively curls toes when pressure is applied to bottom of foot  
 6. The first "milk" to be produced by the breasts  
 13. The sequential process by which infants and children gain various skills and functions  
 14. An increase in physical size

15. Food that should not be given to infants because it can cause Botulism  
 16. Inconsolable crying that lasts 3 hours or more with no physical explanation

1. Immunization that the newborn receives at birth  
 2. Average is 33-35 cm.  
 4. Erikson's stage for the infant

7. Fine, downy hair that covers the newborn's body  
 8. Protects the infant's developing skin and ceases production after birth  
 9. Piaget's stage where infant uses senses and motor skills  
 10. Gross motor skills develop in this fashion  
 11. Characteristic play style of the infant  
 12. Reflex that is elicited by infant's cheek is stroked
