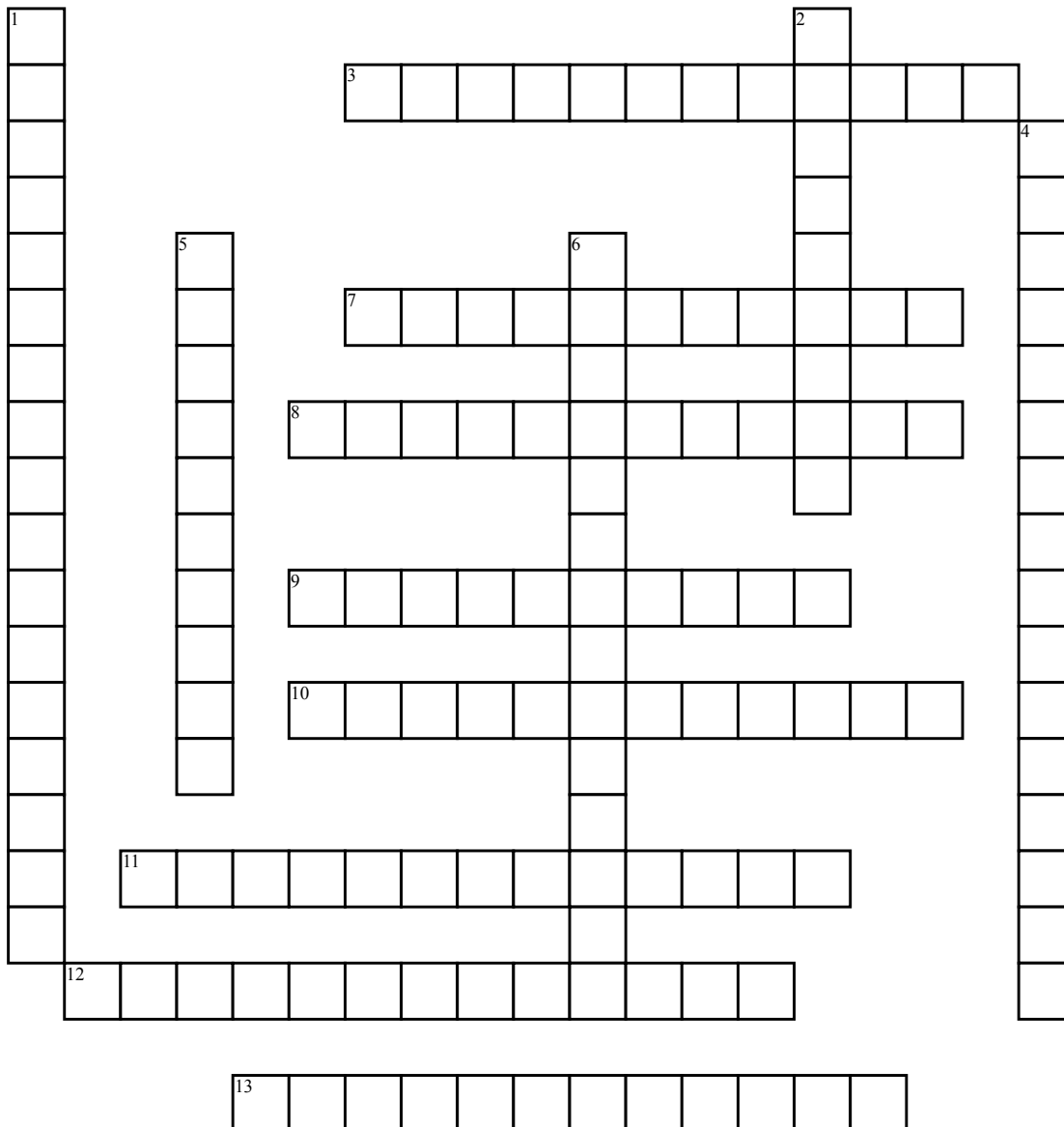


# People of Psychology

- 3.** Helped admit Mary Calkins and tutored her to get her Harvard Ph.D
- 7.** Helped Gazzaniga with the understanding of split brains
- 8.** Discovered that damage to the left temporal lobe (Wernicke's area) people could speak only meaningless words and can disrupt understanding
- 9.** Demonstrated that neurons in the occipital lobe's visual cortex receive information from individual ganglion cells in the retina

- 10.** Established the 1st psychology laboratory
- 11.** Developed the theory of evolution using Natural Selection
