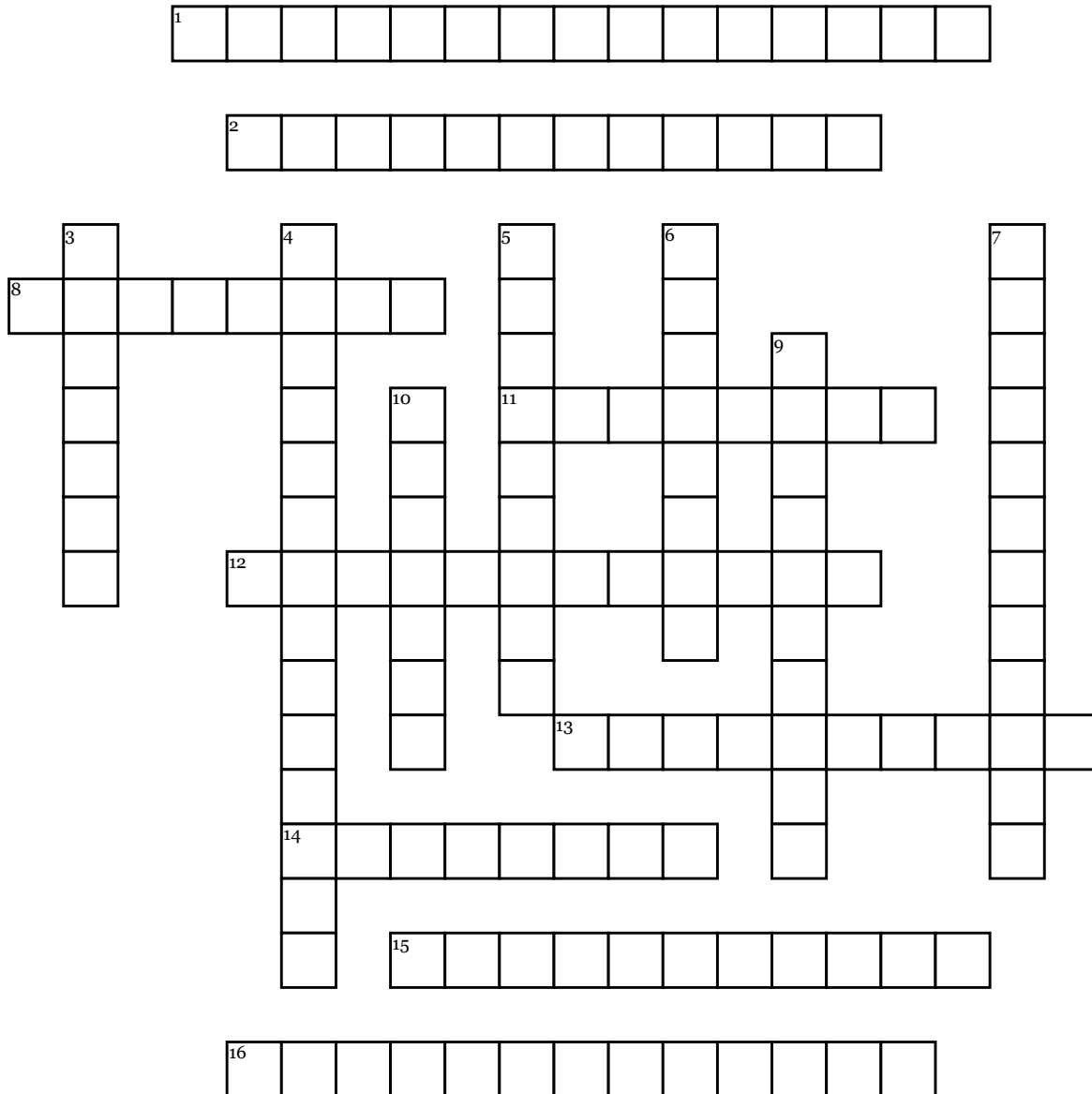


# Perception
