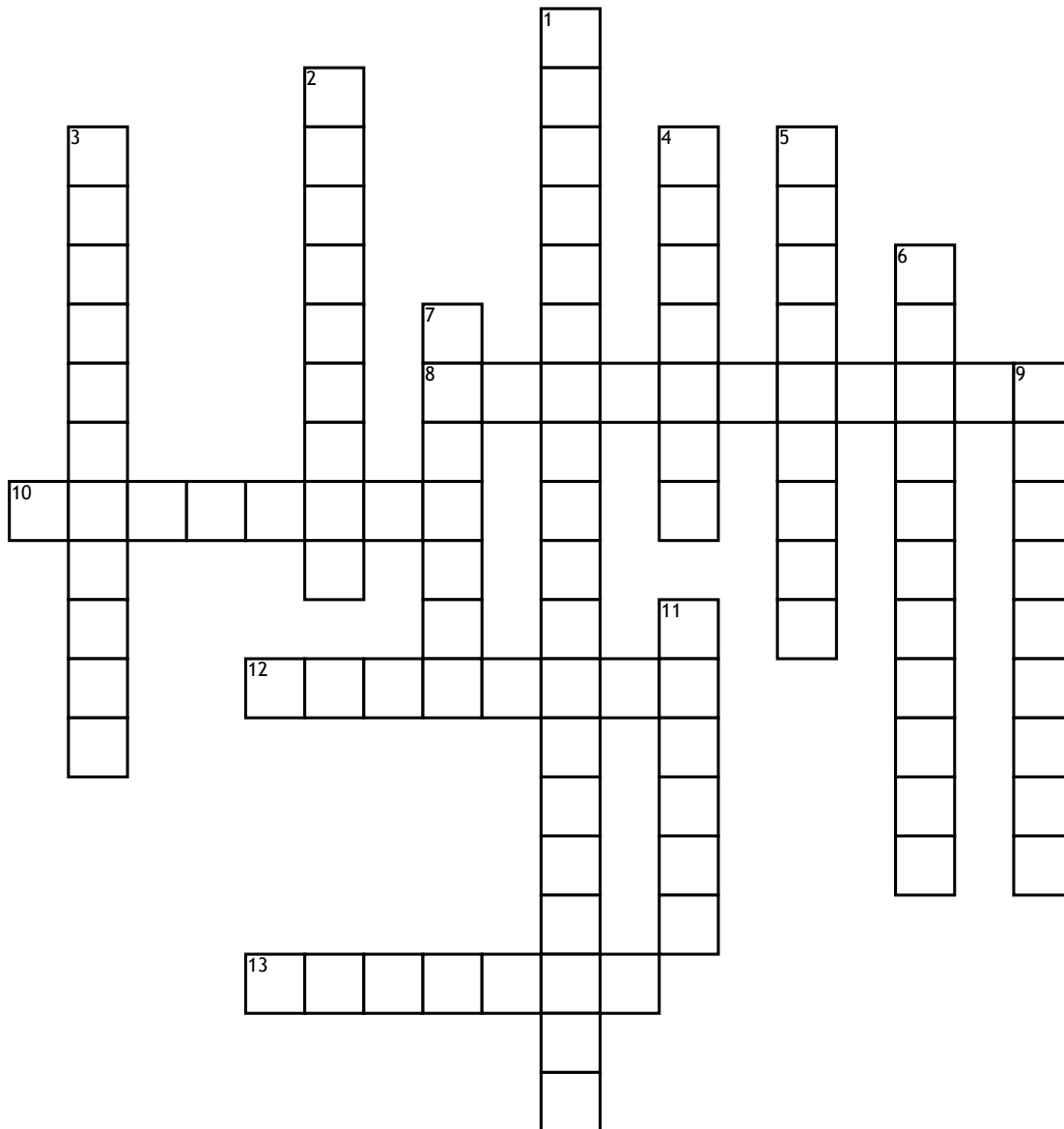


Peripheral IV Fluids

- 8.** A life-threatening complication of IV therapy
10. Slow, intentional introduction of fluid into a vein
12. Complication of IV therapy when vein is injured; looks like a bruise
13. Fluid overload occurs when it is infused too

Down

- 1.** Fluid given to patient with severe blood loss
2. Inflammation of a vein
3. Spike IV bag using
4. Another name for a central line
5. Used in pediatric patients; 60 gtts per mL of fluid

- 6.** Lies just below tubing insertion spike; allows visualization of the drops of solution
7. Tube inserted into a vessel, duct, or cavity
9. Used for adults; 10-15 gtts per mL
11. Open and unobstructed
