| 3. a sudden and decisive action in politics, especially one resulting in a change of government by force or by other means outside of the law COUP | C. PROLETARIAT |
| 4. a form of government in which the supreme power is vested in the people and exercised directly by them | D. CAPITALISM |
| 5. a policy of extending the rule or authority of one nation over another | E. D'ETAT |
| 6. the doctrine that capitalism, which contains the seeds of its own decay, will inevitably be overcome by the socialist order and classless society | F. COMMUNISM |
| 7. the doctrine of asserting the interests of one's own nation, viewed as separate from the interests of other nations or the common interests of all nations | G. SHAH |
| 8. the class of workers who do not possess capital or property and must sell their labor to survive | H. NATIONALISM |
