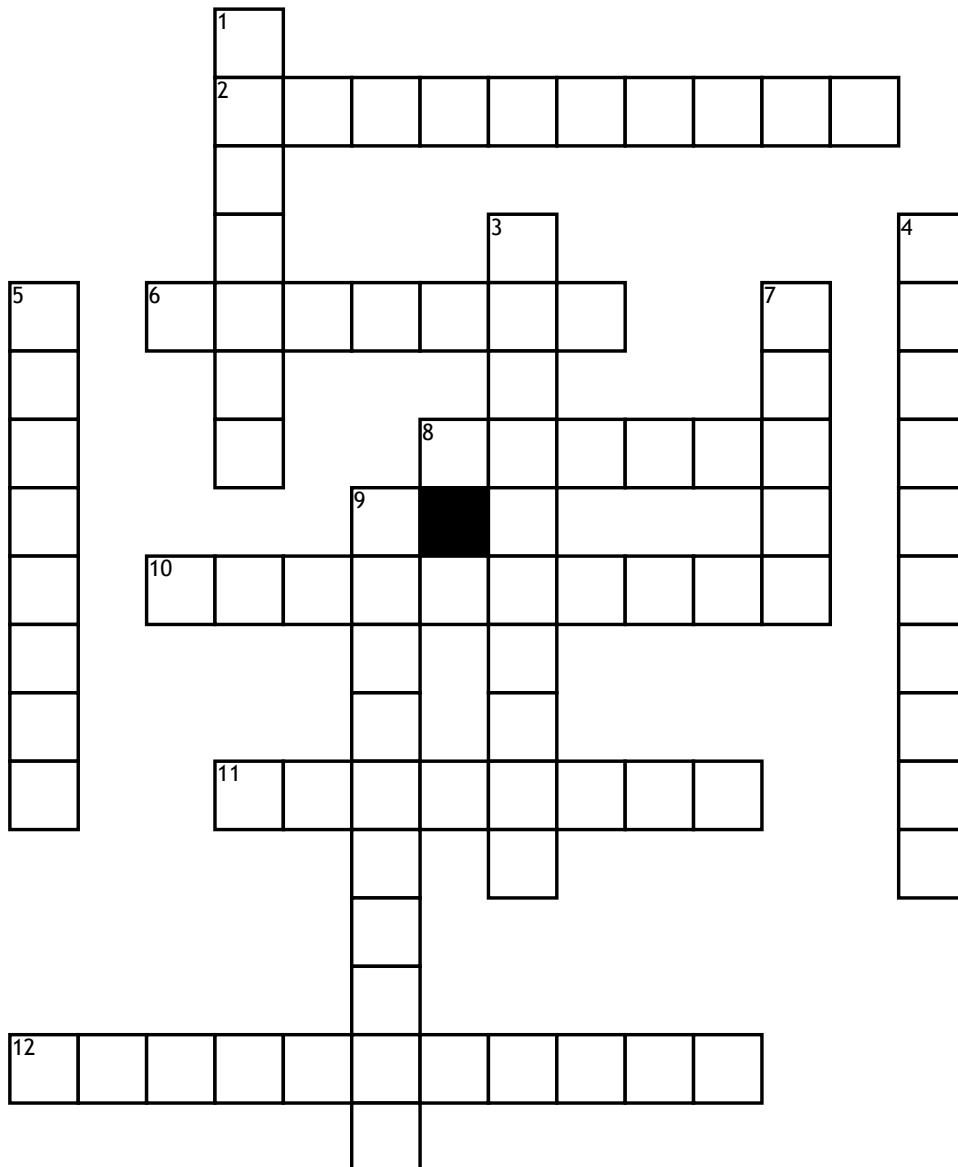

- 2. Used for enterococcus faecalis endocarditis for synergist effects with ceftriaxone
- 6. Anticoagulant that is dosed for non-valvular A-fib based on age, body weight, or serum creatinine
- 8. Dosed for maintenance of T1DM at 0.5-1 units/kg/day

- 10. Anticoagulant used for heparin-induced thrombocytopenia
- 11. Used for sedation of intubated ICU patients
- 12. Antibiotic that is often used for GU infection

- 1. used for DVT/PE treatment with the dosing of 15 mg by mouth BID for 21 days then 20 mg daily

- 3. Antiplatelet agent that can interact with statin drugs
- 4. When making a TPN this electrolyte can form a precipitate with calcium
- 5. Requires INR testing
- 7. SFH uses an extended infusion of this antibiotic
- 9. New antibiotic used for MRSA coverage
