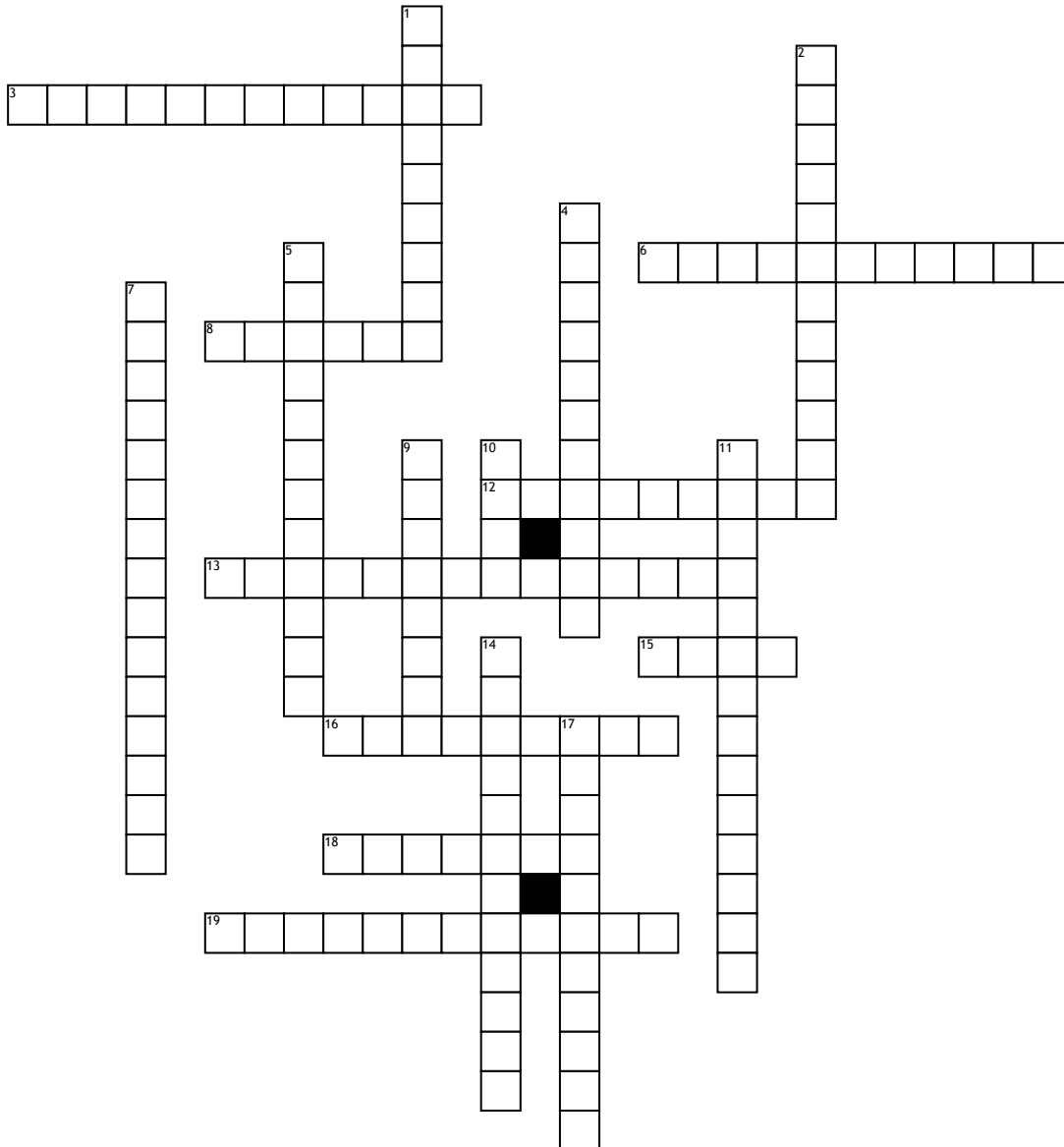


# Pharmacology Crossword
