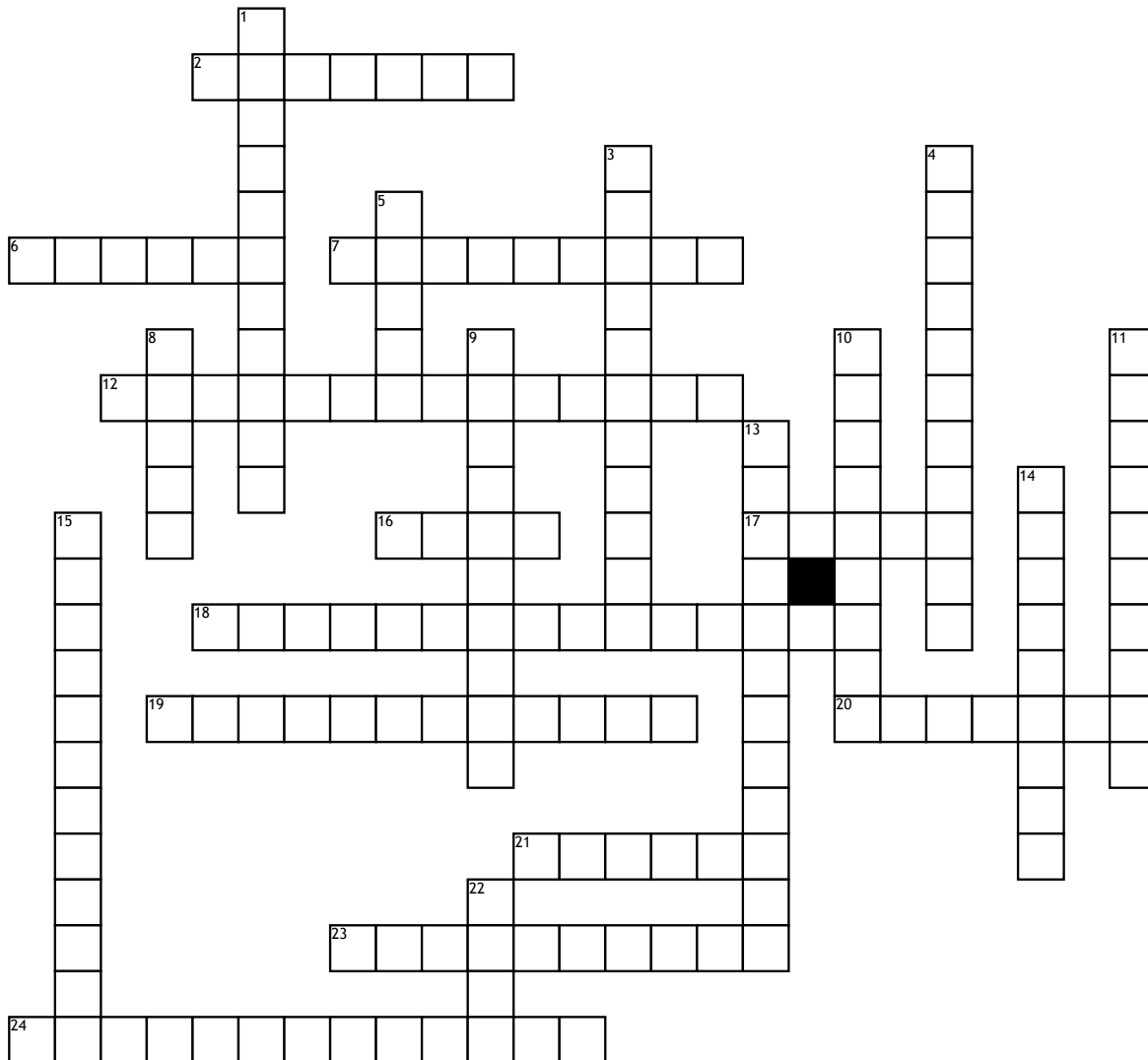

 6. Composed of 10% dissolved solutes and 90% water
 7. White blood cell (WBC)

 19. Primary function is to help in the clotting process. Also known as platelets

1. Improper care of a patient by a health care professional resulting in injury
 3. Red blood cell (RBC)
 4. Typically the third vein of choice due to the location of nerves by the vein. Located on pinky side
 5. Sharpened & slanted cut edge of a needle designed to ease the process of puncturing tissue

8. Has the same chemical composition as plasma except does not contain fibrinogen

9. Failure to provide proper care

10. Disease causing micro-organisms

11. Device used to make the veins easier to find for venipuncture

13. Vein used for most obese patients. Located on thumb side

14. Hardened, or veins that are hard from repeated blood draw
