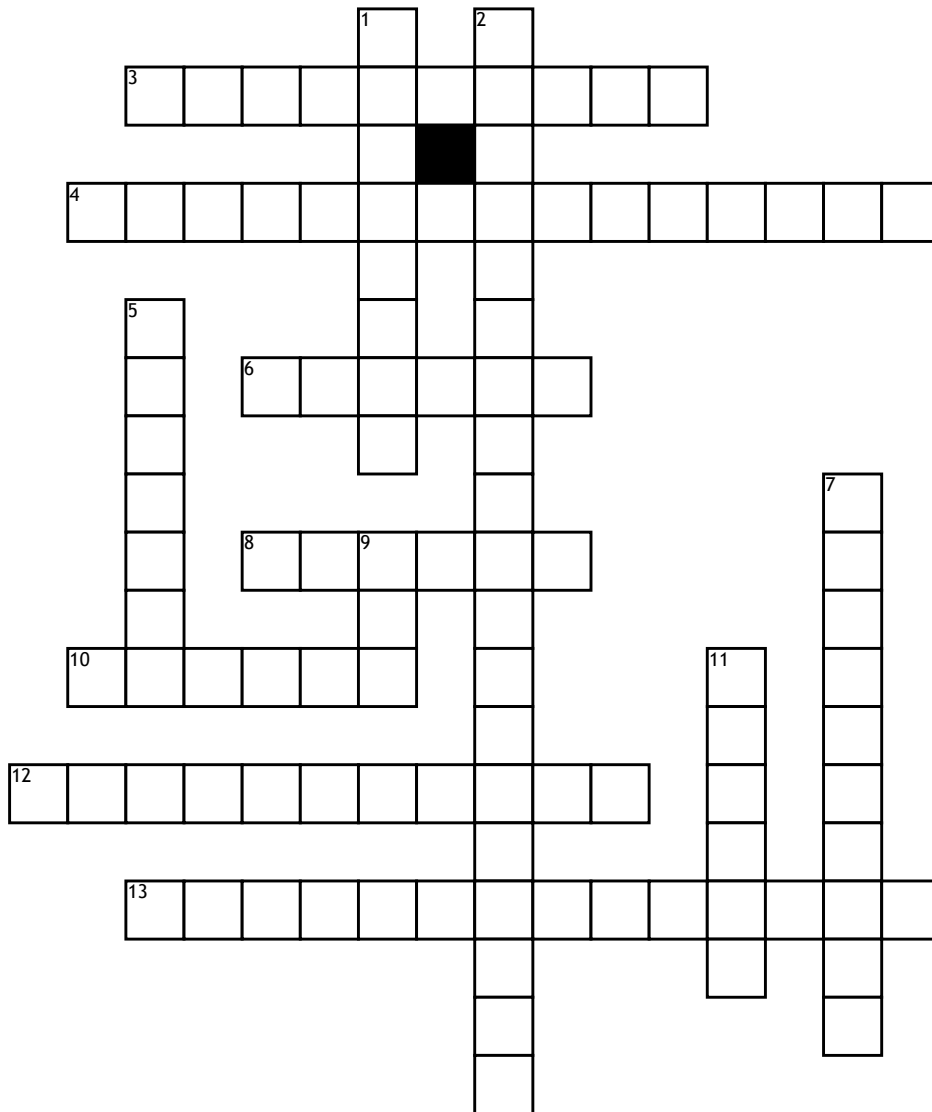


# Phlebotomy



## Across

3. PE, blue top. FTA red top.  
 4. Hold solution 18-24 inches up. Line clamped, slowly release.  
 6. How many seconds is the arm scrub?  
 8. Used for arm scrub, initial 1 inch, 3 inch concentric circles  
 10. What Softgood is scanned in during Step 2?  
 12. This investigation takes place when too much plasma is taken from the donor for whatever reason.
