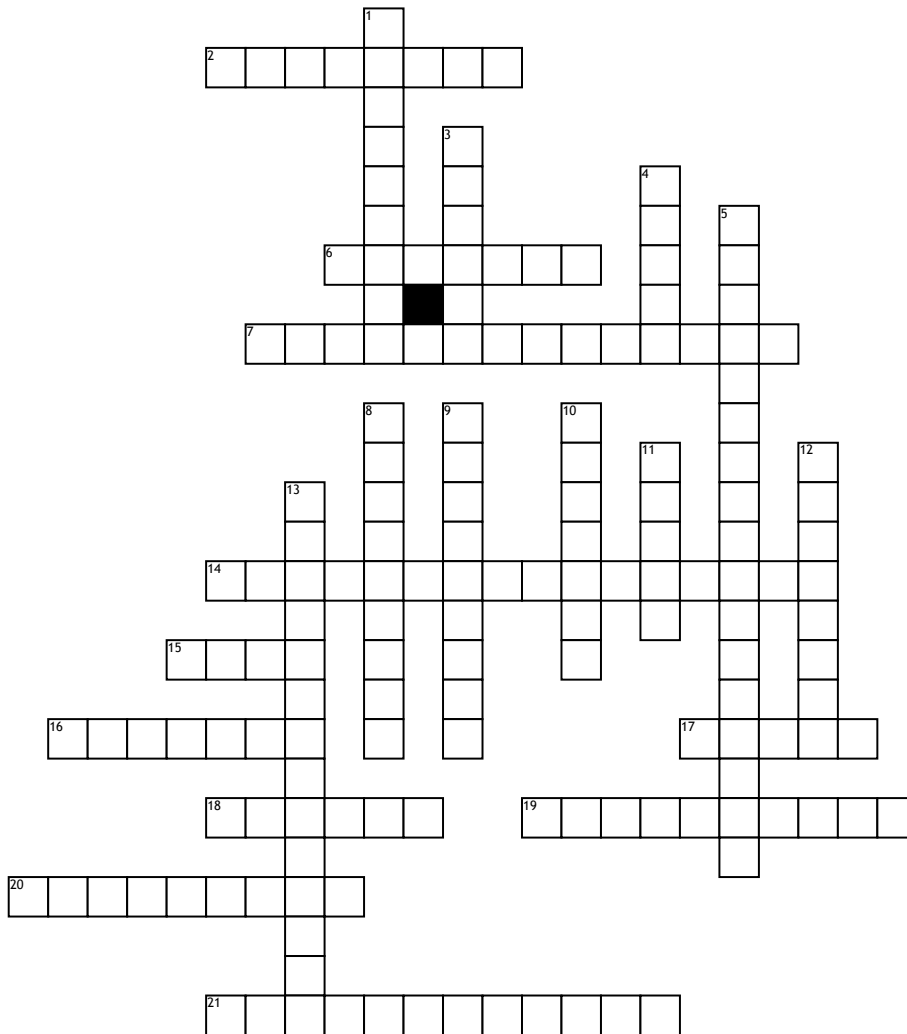

- 2. A letter or combination of letters that represents a phoneme.
- 6. Two letters that stand for a single phoneme (sound).
- 7. Sounds in a syllable represented by two or more letters that are blended together without losing their own identities.
- 14. When a vowel letter is followed by the letter r, it affects the vowel sound so that it is neither short nor long.
- 15. The part of a syllable that includes the vowel sound and any consonant sound(s) that come(s) after it.
- 16. A method in which basic phonetics, the study of human speech sounds, is used to teach beginning reading.
- 17. The consonant sound(s) of a syllable that come(s) before the vowel sound.

- 18. The orthographic symbol placed above vowel graphemes to indicate pronunciation.
- 19. An unstressed sound commonly occurring in unstressed syllables.
- 20. A letter sequence comprised of a vowel grapheme and (an) ending consonant grapheme(s). From these we generate word families.
- 21. any syllable that ends with a vowel sound (phoneme).

- 1. The study of human speech sounds.
- 3. The orthographic symbol placed over a vowel letter to show it is pronounced as a long sound.
- 4. A sound represented by a, e, i, o, u and sometimes y and w in the English alphabet. These are sounds made without closing or restricting the breath channel.

- 5. The ability to recognize spoken words as a sequence of individual sounds.
- 8. A single vowel sound made up of a glide from one vowel sound to another in immediate sequence and pronounced in one syllable.
- 9. A sound represented by any letter of the English alphabet except a, e, i, o, u, w, y. These sounds are made by closing or restricting the breath channel.
- 10. The smallest sound unit of a language that distinguishes one word from another.
- 11. The orthographic symbol placed over a vowel letter to show it is pronounced as a short sound.
- 12. A unit of pronunciation consisting of a vowel alone or a vowel with one or more consonants.
- 13. Any syllable that ends with a consonant phoneme (sound).
