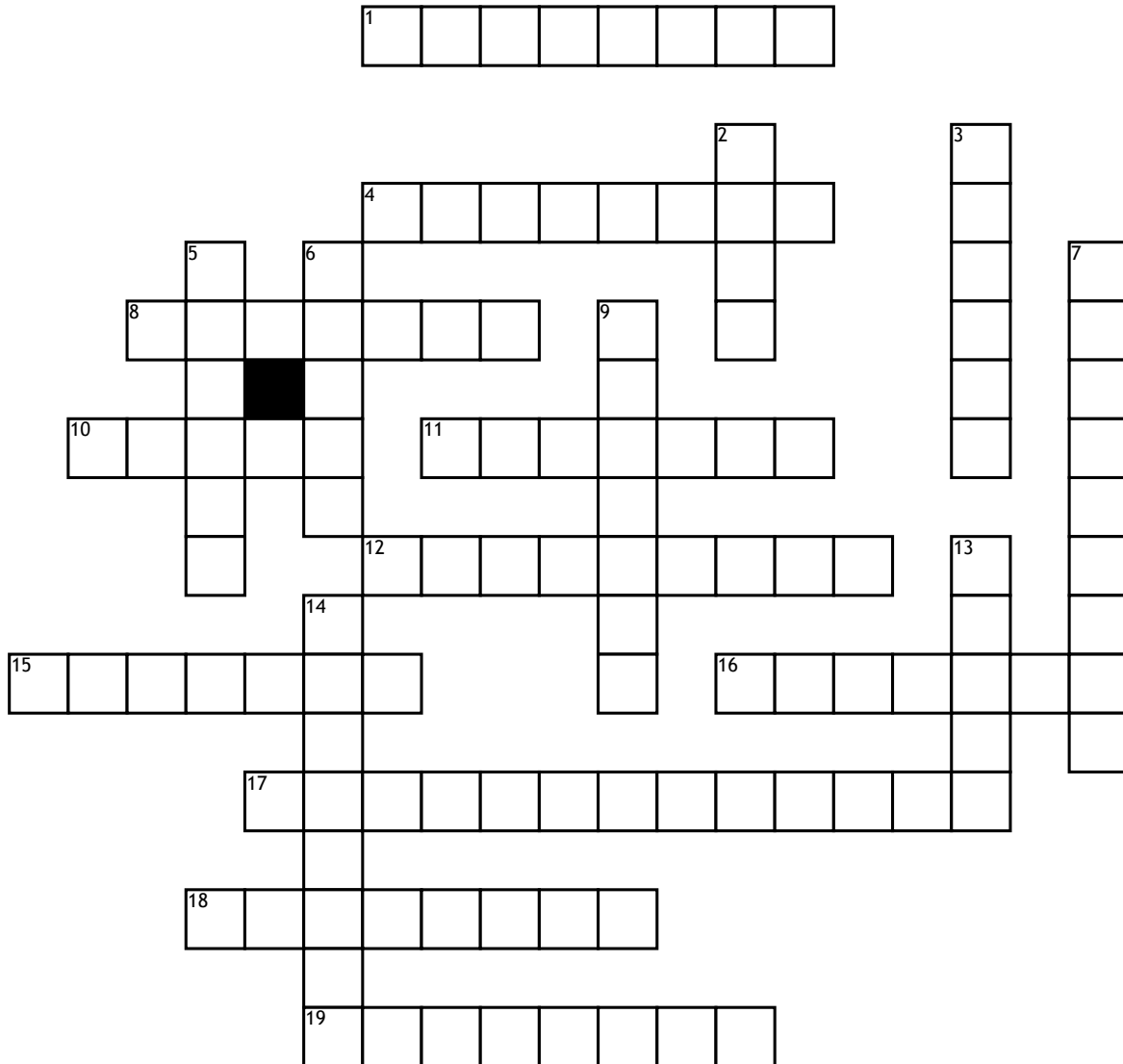

- 4. List of the technical printing information, often appears at the end of the index
- 8. The first two to four pages
- 10. Verbal statement and a visual look, it ties the yearbook together
- 11. Used to separate each of the sections of the yearbook
- 12. The page number and the topic of a spread placed at the bottom of the spread.
