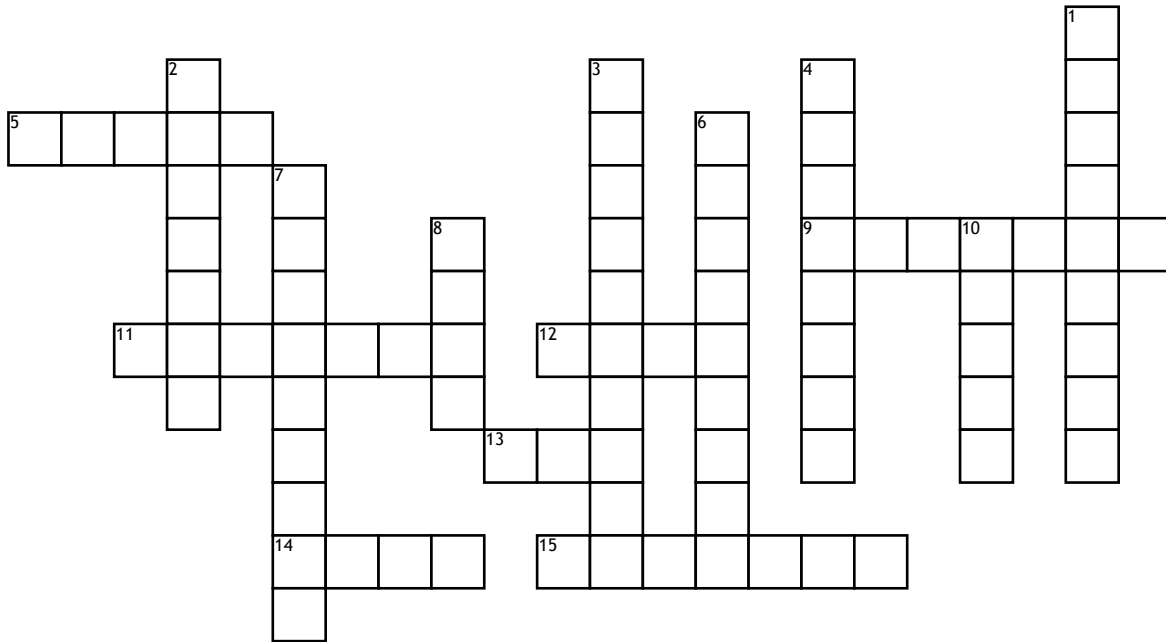


Photoshop Basics



Across

- 5. Small squares that contain color and make up the structure of an image
- 9. It's where you'll find them to create your artwork and perform editing tasks
- 11. The selection (from Cut or Copy) into another part of the image or layer
- 12. Moves back one step and reverses the last action taken
- 13. Create the colors you see
- 14. Color mode for print

- 15. Non-text element like a photo, a piece of clip art, or a graph

Down

- 1. For selecting areas which have reasonably well-defined edges.
- 2. Interface that contains several headings
- 3. Located at the top of the interface underneath the menu bar and changes each time a new tool is selected
- 4. Opens the door to a multitude of pre-designed font libraries

- 6. Is a software that allows users to edit, manipulate photos
- 7. The work area includes the menu bar at the top of your screen, the image window containing an image, and a variety of tools and palettes for editing and adding effects to your document.
- 8. A format for compressing image files
- 10. Like sheets of stacked acetate
