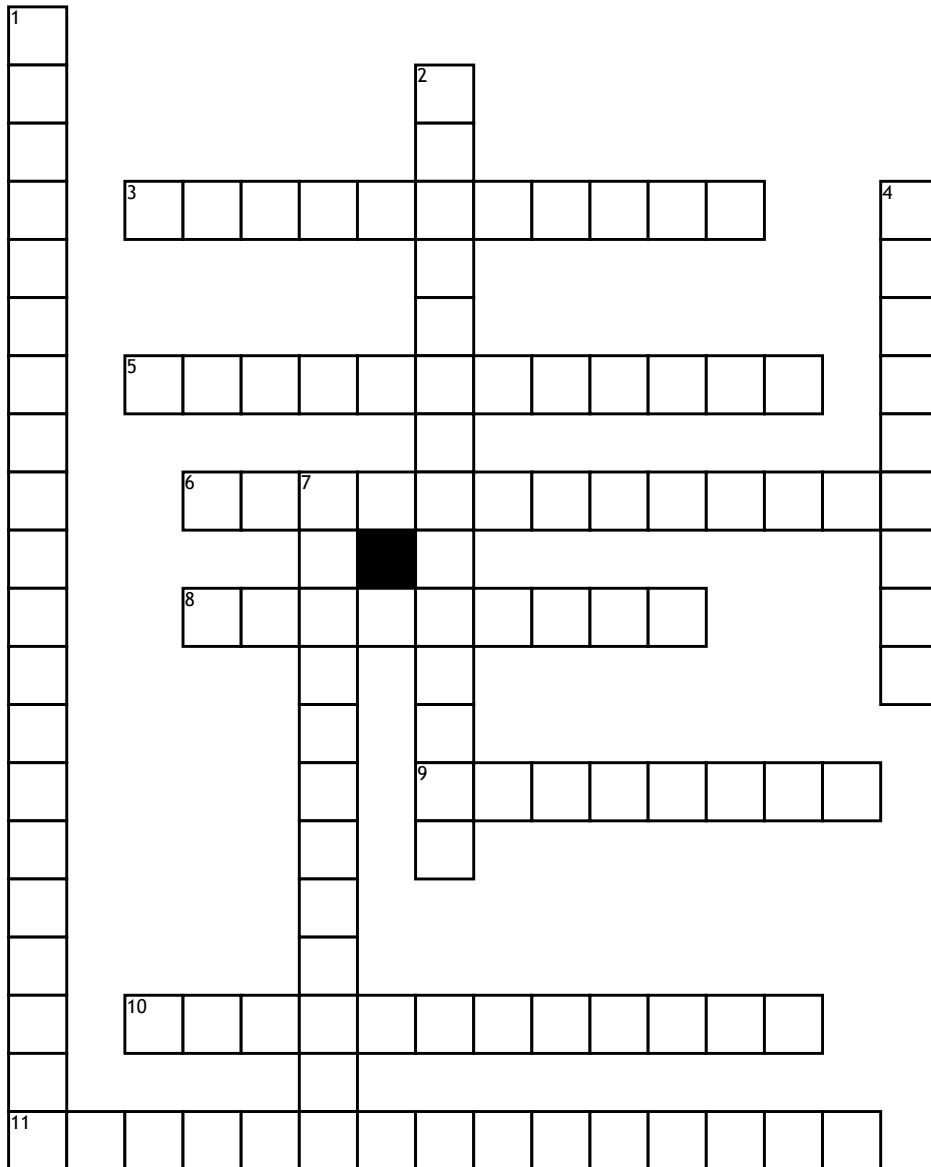


# Physical Features of Canada

- 4. A large body of saltwater in Canada with a surface area of 1,230,000 square kilometers.
