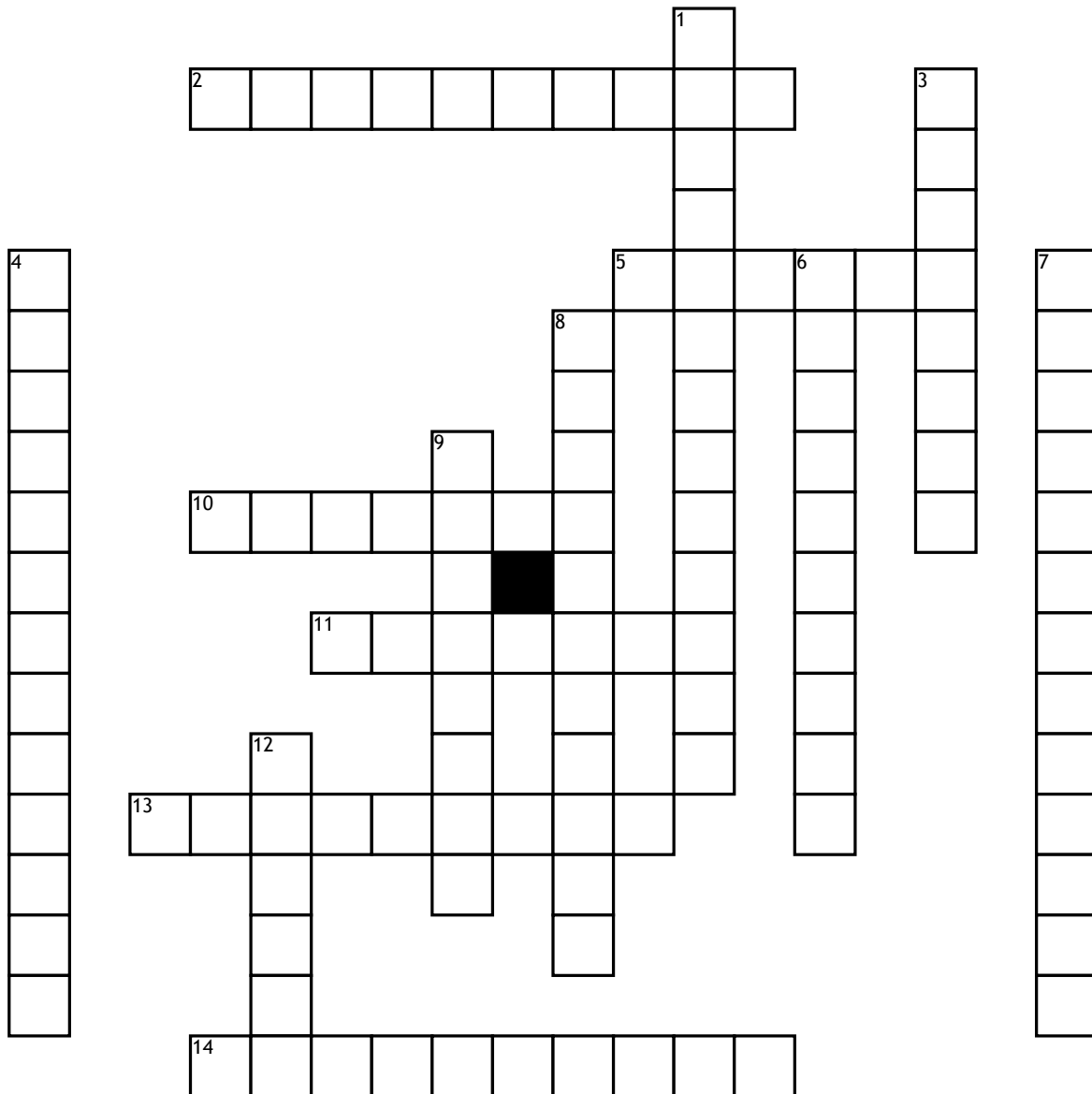

## Across

- 2. Fetal vessels run from the velamentous insertion to the placenta over the opening of the cervical opening
- 5. Cord wrapped around the neck of the fetus one or more times
- 10. Abnormal placental adherence that extends into the myometrium
- 11. Placenta with generalize abnormal adherence to the myometrium
- 13. Separation of placenta from the uterus

- 14. Another term for marginal insertion of the cord into the placenta

- 1. Area of chorionic plate reduced, edges folding up. Results in thickened placenta with decreased surface area to uterine wall
