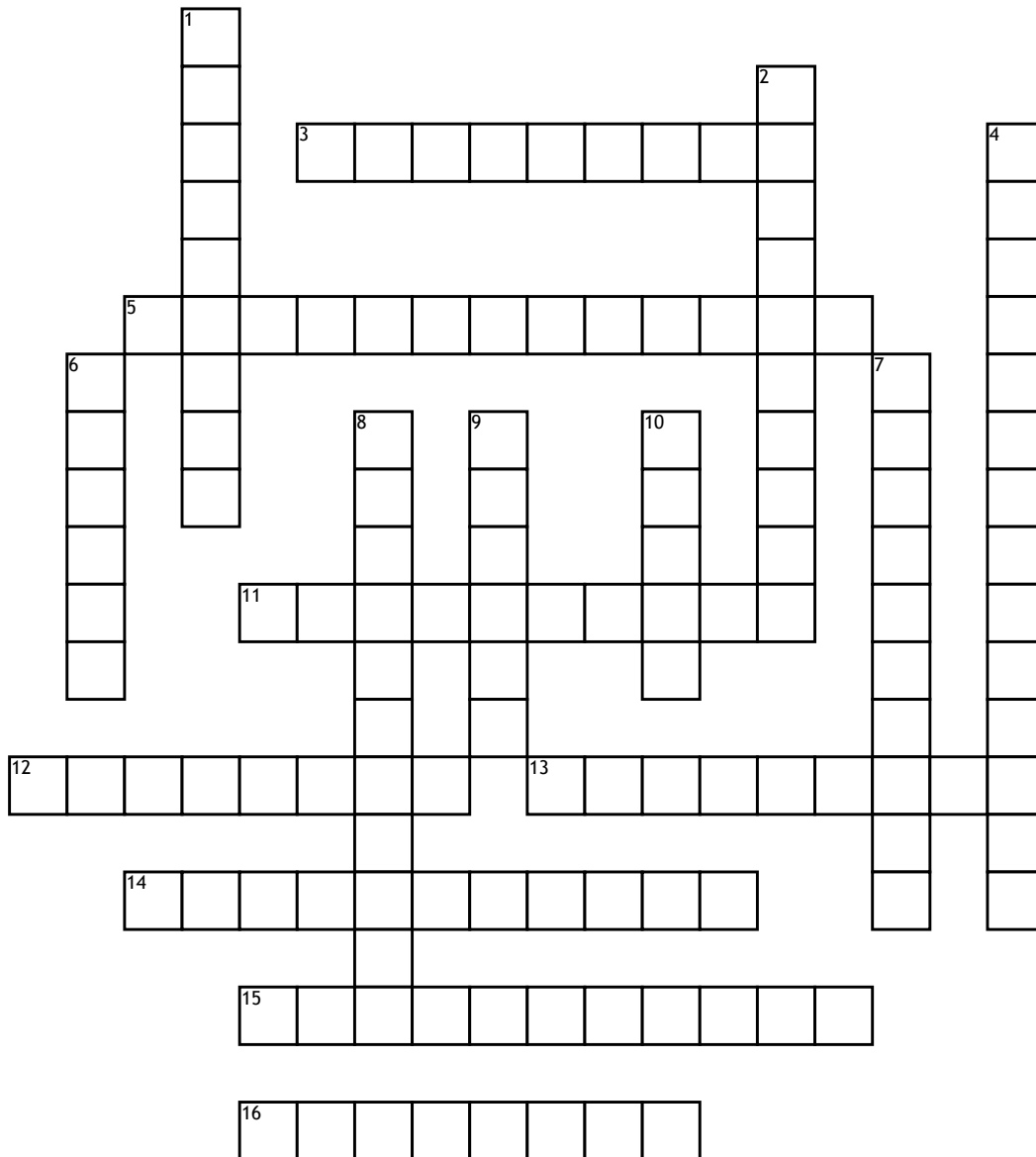


# Plants Vocabulary
