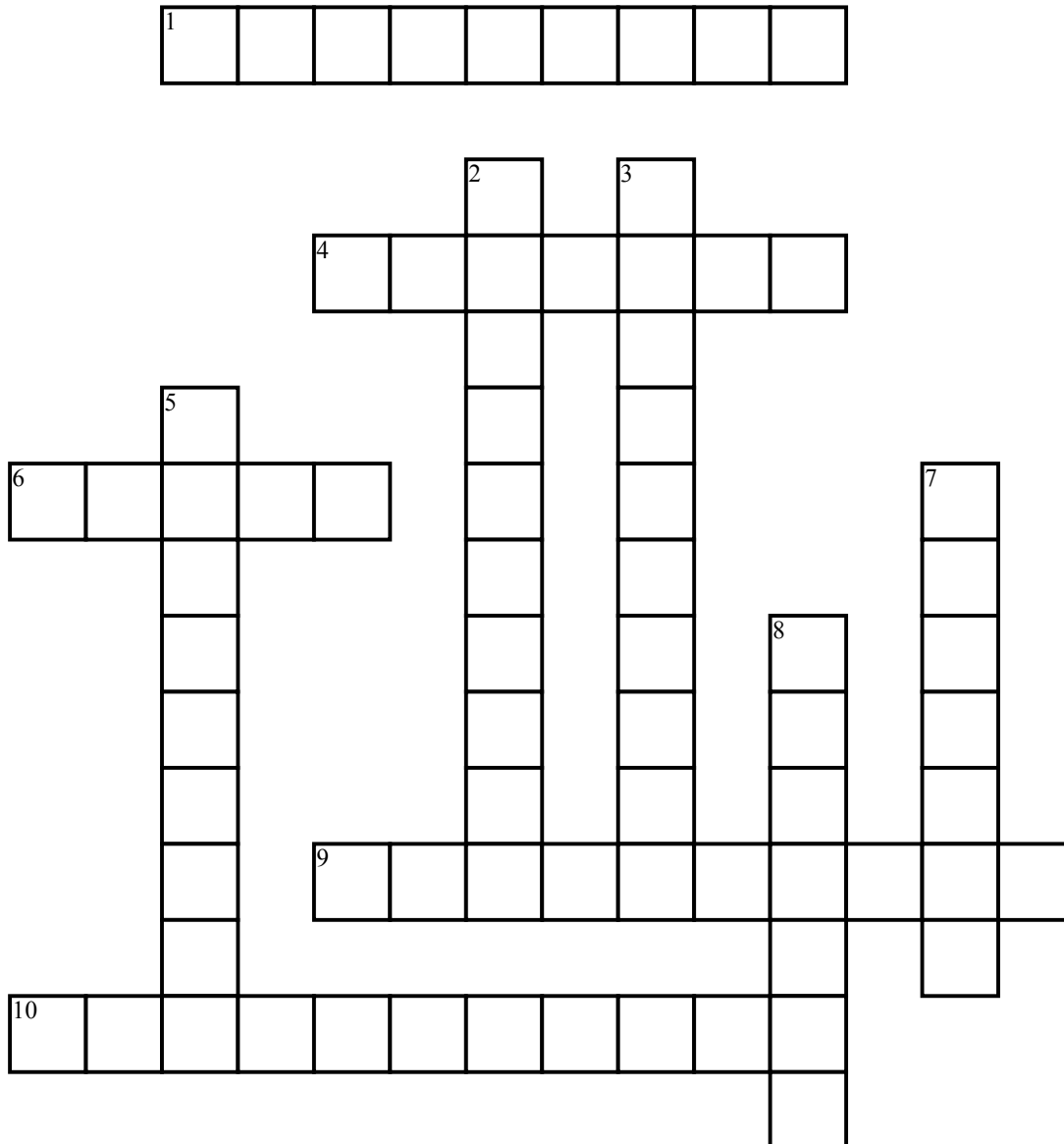


Plate Tectonics
