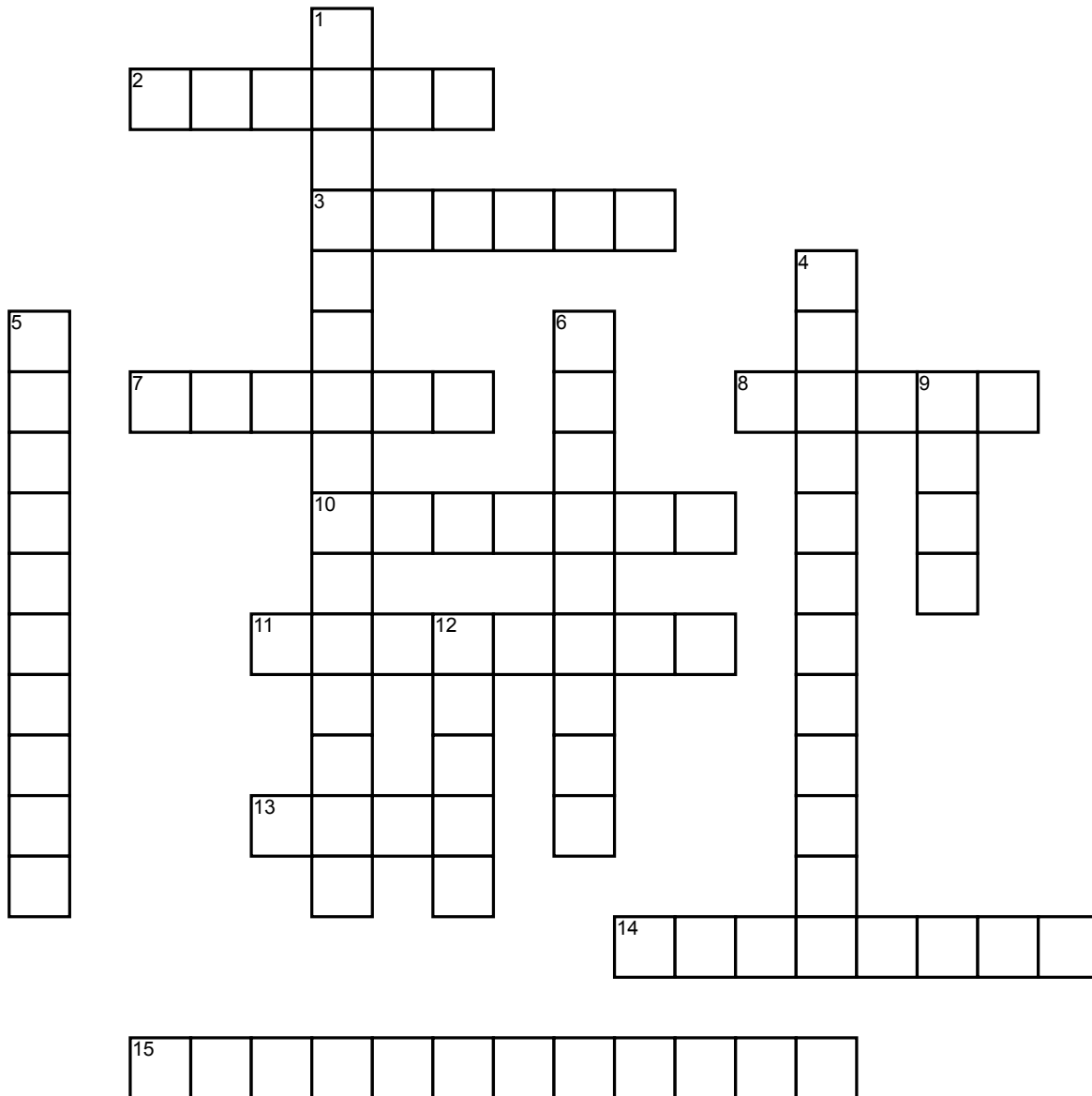


# Poetry Crossword
